SUBJECT; NOTIFICATION BY THE UNITED KINGDOM OF 11 MARCH 1954 UNDER
THE DECISION OF THE CONTRACTING PARTIES OF 24 OCTOBER 1953

I HAVE THE HONOUR TO INFORM YOU THAT I HAVE RECEIVED A SECOND NOTIFICATION FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM UNDER THE PROCEDURES OF THE DECISION OF 24 OCTOBER 1953 (G/65). ONE COPY OF THIS NOTIFICATION IS BEING SUBMITTED IN DOCUMENT SECRET/8 TO EACH CONTRACTING PARTY.

UNDER THE PROCEDURES OF THE DECISION ANY CONTRACTING PARTY WISHING TO REQUEST A CONSULTATION CONCERNING ANY OF THE UNITED KINGDOM PROPOSALS IS ASKED TO NOTIFY ME NOT LATER THAN 10 APRIL 1954. IN CASES WHERE NO SUCH REQUEST IS RECEIVED BY THAT DATE I SHALL NOTIFY THE UNITED KINGDOM GOVERNMENT THAT THE WAIVER GRANTED BY THE CONTRACTING PARTIES WILL APPLY TO THE PRODUCTS CONCERNED.

THE UNITED KINGDOM GOVERNMENT HAS FURNISHED DETAILED STATISTICS OF IMPORTS IN THE PRODUCTS AFFECTED BY THE PROPOSALS: A COPY OF THESE STATISTICS IS BEING SENT UNDER SEPARATE COVER TO THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE COUNTRIES NAMED THEREIN AS SUPPLIERS. A LIMITED NUMBER OF COPIES ARE AVAILABLE FOR OTHER GOVERNMENTS WHICH WISH TO HAVE THEM.
