SUBJECT: TWELFTH SESSION OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT

1. THE TWELFTH SESSION OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT WILL BE HELD ON 4-5 NOVEMBER 1968. THE MEETING WILL OPEN ON MONDAY, 4 NOVEMBER AT 10 A.M. IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS, GENEVA.
2. IT IS PROPOSED THAT THE FOLLOWING SUBJECTS BE INCLUDED ON THE AGENDA FOR DISCUSSION AT THIS SESSION:
  - (i) REVIEW OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PART IV AND RECENT DEVELOPMENTS IN RELATION TO TRADE PROBLEMS OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES.
  - (ii) RESIDUAL IMPORT RESTRICTIONS.
  - (iii) APPLICATION OF THE PRINCIPLE OF NON-RECIPROCITY IN TRADE NEGOTIATIONS.
  - (iv) TARIFF RECLASSIFICATION.
  - (v) SPECIAL TARIFF PROBLEMS OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES.
  - (vi) REPORT OF THE ADVISORY GROUP ON THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE CENTRE.
  - (vii) FUTURE WORK PROGRAMME.
3. AN ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA CONTAINING THESE ITEMS AND ACCOMPANIED BY BACKGROUND INFORMATION ON EACH OF THEM WILL BE CIRCULATED SHORTLY IN COM.TD/W/80.
4. MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE, AND OTHER CONTRACTING PARTIES, ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS WISHING TO BE REPRESENTED BY OBSERVERS AT THE MEETINGS, ARE REQUESTED TO ADVISE ME AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES.
