SUBJECT: WORKING PARTY ON UNITED KINGDOM IMPORT DEPOSIT SCHEME

1. AT THEIR MEETING ON 25 NOVEMBER 1968 THE CONTRACTING PARTIES ESTABLISHED A WORKING PARTY ON THE UNITED KINGDOM IMPORT DEPOSIT SCHEME WITH THE FOLLOWING TERMS OF REFERENCE:

"TO EXAMINE THE IMPORT DEPOSIT SCHEME INTRODUCED BY THE UNITED KINGDOM AND ITS IMPLICATIONS; TO PRESENT A FIRST REPORT TO THE COUNCIL BY 21 JANUARY 1969, AND TO CONTINUE TO BE AVAILABLE FOR CONSULTATION AS NECESSARY."

2. THE WORKING PARTY WILL CONVENE, UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF MR. C. BESA (CHILE), AT 3 P.M. ON 9 DECEMBER IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS. IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE WORKING PARTY WILL COMPLETE ITS WORK ON THE SAME DAY OR AT THE LATEST ON 10 DECEMBER.

3. MEMBERSHIP, CONSISTING OF THOSE COUNTRIES WHICH INDICATE THEIR DESIRE TO PARTICIPATE, WILL BE ISSUED IN A LATER DOCUMENT

4. MEMBERS OF THE WORKING PARTY, AND ANY OTHER CONTRACTING PARTIES, ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS WISHING TO BE REPRESENTED BY OBSERVERS, ARE REQUESTED TO NOTIFY ME BY 6 DECEMBER OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES.
