SUBJECT: MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRADE IN INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS

- 1. AS TENTATIVELY AGREED AT THE LAST MEETING, THE COMMITTEE WILL RECONVENE ON 19 JUNE FOR A MEETING WHICH IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE THROUGH 27 JUNE, TO CONCLUDE ITS FIRST EXAMINATION OF THE INVENTORY OF NON-TARIFF BARRIERS.
- 2. TIME WILL BE SET ASIDE AT THE MEETING FOR CONSIDERATION OF PARTICULAR PROBLEMS OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES.
- 3. AN EFFORT WILL ALSO BE MADE TO CAPRY OUT AS MUCH OF THE NECESSARY REVISION OF THE SECRETARIAT NOTES ON THE FIRST EXAMINATION OF THE INVENTORY AS POSSIBLE. THE COMMITTEE MAY ALSO WISH TO CONSIDER A REPORT BY THE INTERNATIONAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, NON-TARIFF OBSTACLES TO TRADE, COPIES OF WHICH ARE BEING DISTRIBUTED TO MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE.
- 4. THE MEETING WILL BE HELD IN THE IMTERNATIONAL LABOUR OFFICE BEGINNING AT 10 A.M.
- 5. MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE AND CONTRACTING PARTIES, ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS AND INTER-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS WISHING TO BE REPRESENTED BY OBSERVERS AT THE MEETING ARE REQUESTED TO INFORM ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES. THE ATTENDANCE OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES WILL BE ESPECIALLY HELPFUL IN VIEW OF THEIR INTEREST IN THE AGENDA OF THIS MEETING.
