

SUBJECT: COTTON TEXTILES COMMITTEE

1. AS NO OBJECTIONS TO THE PROPOSAL IN GATT/AIR/734 HAVE BEEN RECEIVED, THE COTTON TEXTILES COMMITTEE WILL MEET FROM 8-10 OCTOBER 1969. THE MEETING WILL BE HELD AT THE PALAIS DES NATIONS, GENEVA, BEGINNING AT 3 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY, 8 OCTOBER.
2. THE MAIN MATTERS WHICH I BELIEVE SHOULD RECEIVE CONSIDERATION BY THE COMMITTEE ARE:
  - (i) THE SEVENTH ANNUAL REVIEW OF THE OPERATION OF THE ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES AND A REPORT TO THE CONTRACTING PARTIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 8(c) OF THE ARRANGEMENT;
  - (ii) ADJUSTMENTS IN THE COTTON TEXTILE INDUSTRY;
  - (iii) DISCUSSION CONCERNING THE FUTURE OF THE ARRANGEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 8(d).
3. WORKING PAPERS ON (i) AND (ii) ABOVE WILL BE CIRCULATED IN DUE COURSE.
4. MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE, AS WELL AS OTHER CONTRACTING PARTIES AND ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS WISHING TO BE REPRESENTED BY OBSERVERS AT THIS MEETING, ARE REQUESTED TO INFORM ME OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES NOT LATER THAN 3 OCTOBER 1969.
