

## SUBJECT: TRADE ARRANGEMENTS BETWEEN INDIA, THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC AND YUGOSLAVIA

1. ON 10 SEPTEMBER 1969 THE COUNCIL APPOINTED A WORKING PARTY WITH THE FOLLOWING TERMS OF REFERENCE:

- (i) TO CONSULT WITH INDIA, THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC AND YUGOSLAVIA, AS PROVIDED FOR UNDER PARAGRAPH 1(b) OF THE DECISION OF 14 NOVEMBER 1968, WITH RESPECT TO THE PROTOCOL OF 16 JULY 1969, AMENDING THE TRADE EXPANSION AND ECONOMIC CO-OPERATION ACCEPTENT OF 23 DECEMBER 1967, AND TO REPORT TO THE COUNCIL; AND
- (ii) TO CARRY OUT THE REVIEW OF THE DECISION OF 14 NOVEMBER 1968 AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH 1(c) OF THE DECISION, AND TO REPORT TO THE COUNCIL WITH A RECOMMENDATION AS TO ITS EXTENSION, MODIFICATION OR TERMINATION.
- 2. THE MEMBERSHIP WAS ESTABLISHED AS FOLLOWS:

3. THE WORKING PARTY WILL HAVE A FIRST MEETING ON 26 SEPTEMBER 1969 AT 10 A.M. IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS GENEVA.

4. MEMBERS OF THE WORKING PARTY, AND OTHER CONTRACTING PARTIES, ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS WISHING TO BE REPRESENTED BY OBSERVERS, ARE REQUESTED TO NOTIFY ME BY 24 SEPTEMBER 1969 OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES.
