SUBJECT: DECLARATION ON THE CONTINUED APPLICATION OF SCHEDULES TO THE
GENERAL AGREEMENT - EXTENSION OF TIME LIMIT FOR SIGNATURE BY HAITI

THE GOVERNMENT OF HAITI HAS REQUESTED THE APPROVAL OF THE CONTRACTING PARTIES, SIGNATORIES TO THE DECLARATION ON THE CONTINUED APPLICATION OF SCHEDULES, TO AN EXTENSION OF THE TIME LIMIT WHICH ENDED ON 30 JUNE 1955 IN ORDER TO ENABLE ITS REPRESENTATIVE TO SIGN THIS DECLARATION.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURE OF NEGATIVE UNANIMITY ADOPTED BY THE INTERSESSIONAL COMMITTEE (SEE DOCUMENTS IC/W/40 AND IC/SR.20), THOSE CONTRACTING PARTIES WHICH ARE SIGNATORIES TO THE DECLARATION ARE INVITED TO EXPRESS THEIR VIEWS ON THIS REQUEST BEFORE 30 SEPTEMBER 1955. IF NO OBJECTION IS LODGED BY THIS DATE THE TIME LIMIT FOR SIGNATURE BY THE GOVERNMENT OF HAITI WILL BE EXTENDED UNTIL 30 OCTOBER 1955.
