SUBJECT: SPECIAL GROUP ON TRADE IN TROPICAL PRODUCTS

AT ITS RESUMED SIXTEENTH SESSION ON 26 MAY 1970, THE COMMITTEE ON TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT AGREED THAT THE SPECIAL GROUP ON TRADE IN TROPICAL PRODUCTS WOULD MEET IN THE SECOND HALF OF JULY 1970. ACCORDINGLY, THE SPECIAL GROUP WILL BE CONVENED ON TUESDAY, 21 JULY AT 10 A.M. IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS.

THE FOLLOWING MATTERS WILL BE CONSIDERED:

1. GENERAL REVIEW OF SITUATION IN REGARD TO SIX PRIORITY GROUPS;
2. PROBLEMS OF NEW AND IMPROVED FORMS OF NATURAL RUBBER (SGTP/16);
3. DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO IMPORT DUTIES AND INTERNAL CHARGES IMPOSED ON TROPICAL PRODUCTS SINCE THE MINISTERIAL CONCLUSIONS OF 1963 (BISD TWELFTH SUPPLEMENT).

THE SECRETARIAT WILL ISSUE DOCUMENTATION ON POINTS ONE AND THREE.

MEMBERS OF THE SPECIAL GROUP, AS WELL AS OTHER CONTRACTING PARTIES AND ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS WISHING TO BE REPRESENTED BY OBSERVERS AT THE MEETING, ARE REQUESTED TO INFORM ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES.
