SUBJECT: CONSULTATIONS ON BALANCE-OF-PAYMENTS IMPORT RESTRICTIONS

1. THE COMMITTEE ON BALANCE-OF-PAYMENTS IMPORT RESTRICTIONS WILL CONVENE ON 15 OCTOBER TO CONDUCT CONSULTATIONS WITH FOUR CONTRACTING PARTIES, AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING:

YUGOSLAVIA	THURSDAY, 15 OCTOBER	10 A.M.
UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC	MONDAY, 19 OCTOBER	10 A.M.
GREECE	WEDNESDAY, 21 OCTOBER	3 P.M.
INDONESIA	THURSDAY, 22 OCTOBER	3 P.M.

2. AS INSTRUCTED BY THE COUNCIL AT ITS MEETING ON 29 SEPTEMBER, THE COMMITTEE WILL, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CONSULTATION WITH YUGOSLAVIA, ALSO EXAMINE THE YUGOSLAV SPECIAL IMPORT CHARGE REFERRED TO IN DOCUMENT L/3419.

3. THE CONSULTATION WITH INDONESIA WILL BE OF THE "EXPANDED" TYPE.

4. TWO OTHER CONSULTATIONS DUE FOR 1970, NAMELY THOSE WITH GHANA AND NEW ZEALAND, HAVE BEEN POSTPONED FOR PRACTICAL REASONS; CONTRACTING PARTIES WILL BE INFORMED OF THE DATES FOR THESE IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

5. MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE, THE CONSULTING GOVERNMENTS, AS WELL AS OTHER CONTRACTING PARTIES, ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS WISHING TO BE REPRESENTED BY OBSERVERS AT THESE MEETINGS, ARE REQUESTED TO INFORM ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES.
