SUBJECT: COMMITTEE ON TRADE IN INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS

1. THE NEXT MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRADE IN INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS WILL BE HELD FROM 12 TO 14 JUNE INCLUSIVE, AND NOT FROM 13 TO 16 JUNE AS ORIGINALLY PLANNED. THE MEETING WILL BEGIN AT 3 P.M. ON 12 JUNE AND WILL BE HELD IN THE WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANIZATION HEADQUARTERS IN GENEVA. THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING IS TO START THE WORK ON TECHNIQUES AND MODALITIES FOR MULTILATERAL GATT NEGOTIATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MANDATE ADOPTED ON 24 MARCH 1972.
