SUBJECT: COMMITTEE ON TRADE IN INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS

1. THE NEXT MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRADE IN INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS WILL BE HELD ON 18 AND 19 JANUARY IN THE GOVERNING BODY ROOM AT THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR OFFICE. THE MEETING WILL BEGIN AT 10.30 A.M. ON 18 JANUARY.
2. THE CHAIRMAN HAS PROPOSED THE FOLLOWING ITEMS FOR INCLUSION IN THE AGENDA (SEE COM.IND/W/93):
 - (a) DETAILED EXAMINATION OF A LIMITED NUMBER OF TECHNIQUES FOR NEGOTIATING ON TARIFFS, WHICH MIGHT BE USED IN THE FORTHCOMING NEGOTIATIONS;
 - (b) REVIEW OF THE ILLUSTRATIVE LIST OF NON-TARIFF MEASURES;
 - (c) SAFEGUARDS;
 - (d) EXAMINATION OF THE IMPLICATIONS FOR DEVELOPING COUNTRIES OF VARIOUS TECHNIQUES AND MODALITIES, AT THE REQUEST OF THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES;
 - (e) PROGRAMME OF MEETINGS FOR THE COMMITTEE AND ITS SUBORDINATE BODIES.
3. THE MAIN DOCUMENTS ARE THE COMMITTEE'S REPORT TO THE COUNCIL, L/3756, AND THE SUMMING-UP BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CONTRACTING PARTIES AT THE TWENTY-EIGHTH SESSION, L/3773/Rev.1. THESE DOCUMENTS CONTAIN REFERENCES TO THE OTHER DOCUMENTS RELEVANT TO THE AGENDA ITEMS ABOVE.
4. MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE AND CONTRACTING PARTIES, ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENTS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS WISHING TO BE REPRESENTED BY OBSERVERS, AND NON-GATT DEVELOPING COUNTRIES HAVING NOTIFIED THEIR WISH TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PREPARATORY WORK FOR THE TRADE NEGOTIATIONS, ARE REQUESTED TO INFORM ME OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES.
