

GATT Office Circular No. 315

OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL

1. The ever-increasing demands placed on the GATT secretariat have inevitably had repercussions for the work of the Office of the Director-General. I have therefore decided to make some organisational changes designed to enhance the ability of that Office to deal with its responsibilities, with immediate effect.
2. The Office is placed under the overall responsibility of Mr. Arif Hussain, who is designated Director of the Office of the Director-General. The secretarial staff of the office will report to Mr. Hussain. That staff will consist of Mrs. Moira Redecker, as well as a senior secretary and a junior clerk, both to be designated. An internal vacancy announcement for the position of senior secretary will be issued shortly.
3. Mrs. Elisabeth Hutchinson is designated Private Assistant to the Director-General, reporting to him.
4. The situation of Mr. Lindén as Special Adviser and of Miss Murphy remains unchanged.
