FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME

Time-table and Curriculum of Studies with  
the Trade Policy Division

1. The part of the programme of studies to be guided by officers of the Trade Policy Division will begin on 26 April. The talks and discussions will be suspended for the duration of the sixteenth session of the CONTRACTING PARTIES, to be resumed on 13 June.
2. An approximate time-table showing the principal subjects to be dealt with during this period and the officers in charge of the discussions is given overleaf. The exact date and time for taking up each subject will be announced in due course by the officer concerned. For a detailed description of most of the subject matters, see GATT Office Circulars 56/Add.2 and 56/Add.1, copies of which may be obtained from Mme Feinsilber.
3. As in the past, each fellow is required to indicate a field or fields (see the table of subjects overleaf) in which he wishes to acquire practical knowledge through active participation in the work of the Division. The fellows are requested to indicate to Mme Feinsilber as soon as possible the field or fields of their preference so that arrangements can be made accordingly.
