DENMARK EXTENDS IMPORT LIBERALIZATION

The Danish authorities have informed the GATT secretariat that as of 1 January 1962 liberalization towards countries within the Danish freelist area has been extended to include the following items:

Deep-frozen fish fillets

Cranberry, fresh

Pyrotechnic articles, <u>except</u> for life-saving purposes or for distress signals (previously liberalized)

Stencils

Electric accumulators, <u>except</u> alkaline accumulators and parts of accumulators (previously liberalized)

Pipe and reed organs, including harmoniums and the like

Brushes of a kind used as parts of machines
