Biographical Note on Mr. Julio A. Lacarte, Chairman of the Contracting Parties
to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade

He has also been Representative to the Organization of American States and Vice-President of the Council of the Organization of American States. At the present time Mr. Lacarte is Ambassador to the Federal Republic of Germany and Representative to the European Economic Community and to GATT.
