CORRIGENDUM TO THE SUMMARY RECORD OF SIXTEENTH MEETING (E/PC/T/C.6/50)

Page 9, last paragraph but one on the page should read:

"The Delegate for the United Kingdom explained his attitude towards the proposed deletion from Article 51, paragraph 4 of the London text (now proposed to be transferred to Article 53) of the words 'provided that those countries which are largely interested in the commodity but which do not fall precisely under either of the above classes, shall have an appropriate voice'.

"It was arguable that the export or import position of such a country is fortuitous: it might export the commodity in one year and import it in another. Accordingly, its consumption and production were a criterion for participation which must be given appropriate weight alongside the criterion of importation and exportation."
