office of information technology-server team manager with the Anne Arundel County Government. "So, when Donnie came around, he helped formalize a lot of the patch management policies."

Regarding his leadership style, Green said he plans to stay the course in his role at DoIT.

"When you look at the industry and the coined terms, I'm more of a servant-leader," said Green. "Yes, I'm leading a [team] and want to keep us marching forward, but I look at it as I'm working for you guys. So, I ask, 'What do I need to provide to you to make your job better, to make you more efficient, and to make you better at your job?"

While at DoIT, Green said one of his top priorities is to strive for efficiency and build upon the agency's relationships with other agencies and municipalities in Maryland.
