

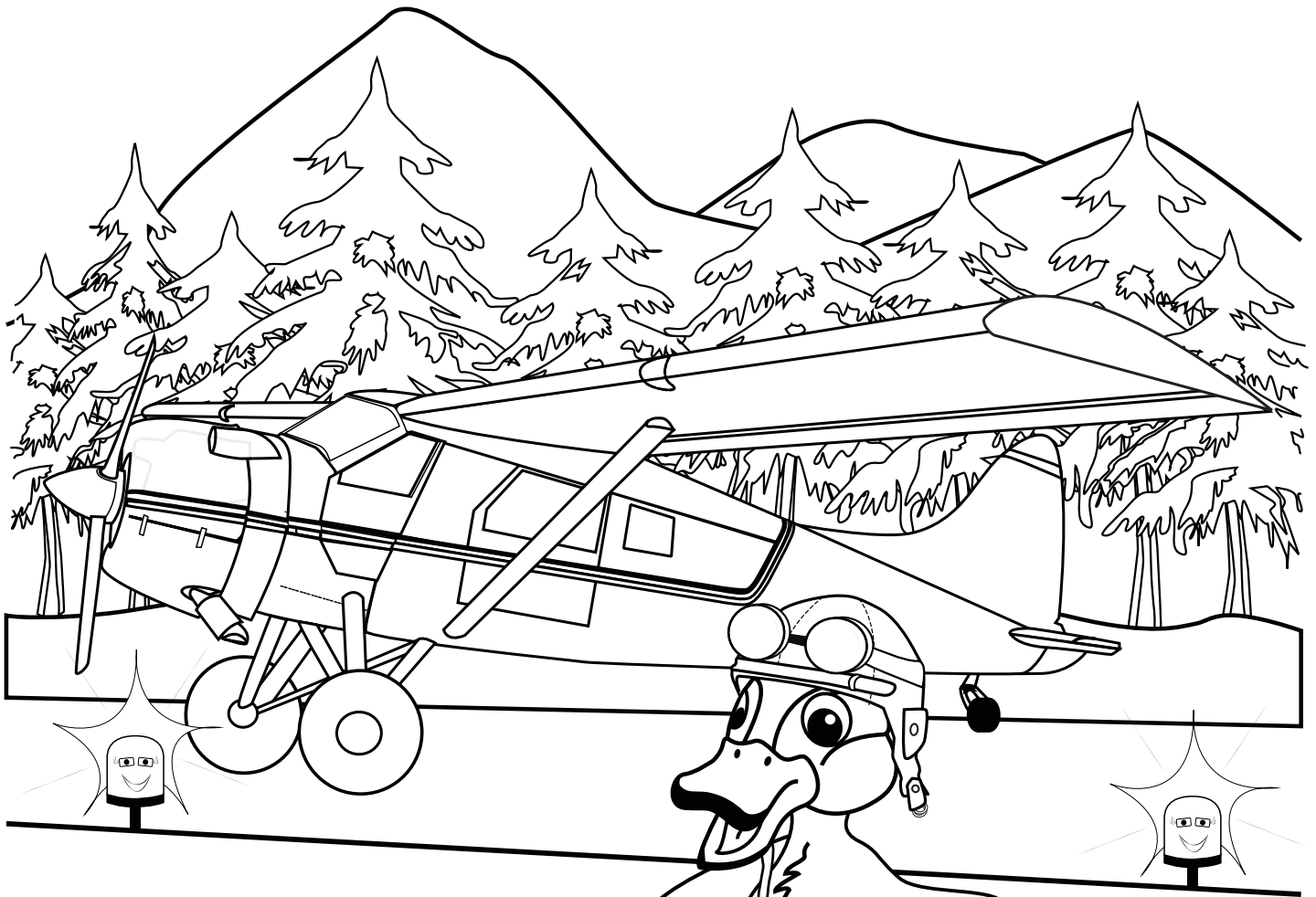

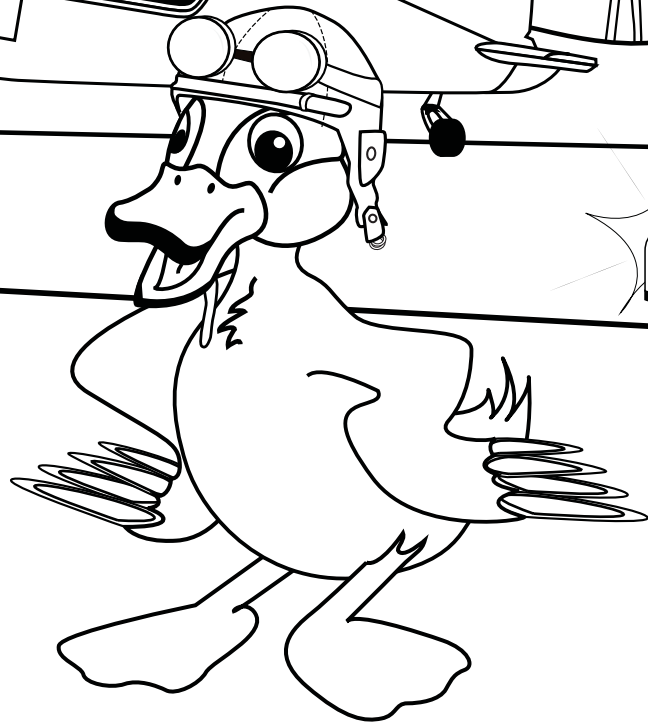
Runways are for Airplanes



Willy Widgeon is a Bush pilot. He flies all around Alaska. He knows that runways are for airplanes. If runways are safe, he can make safe landings.



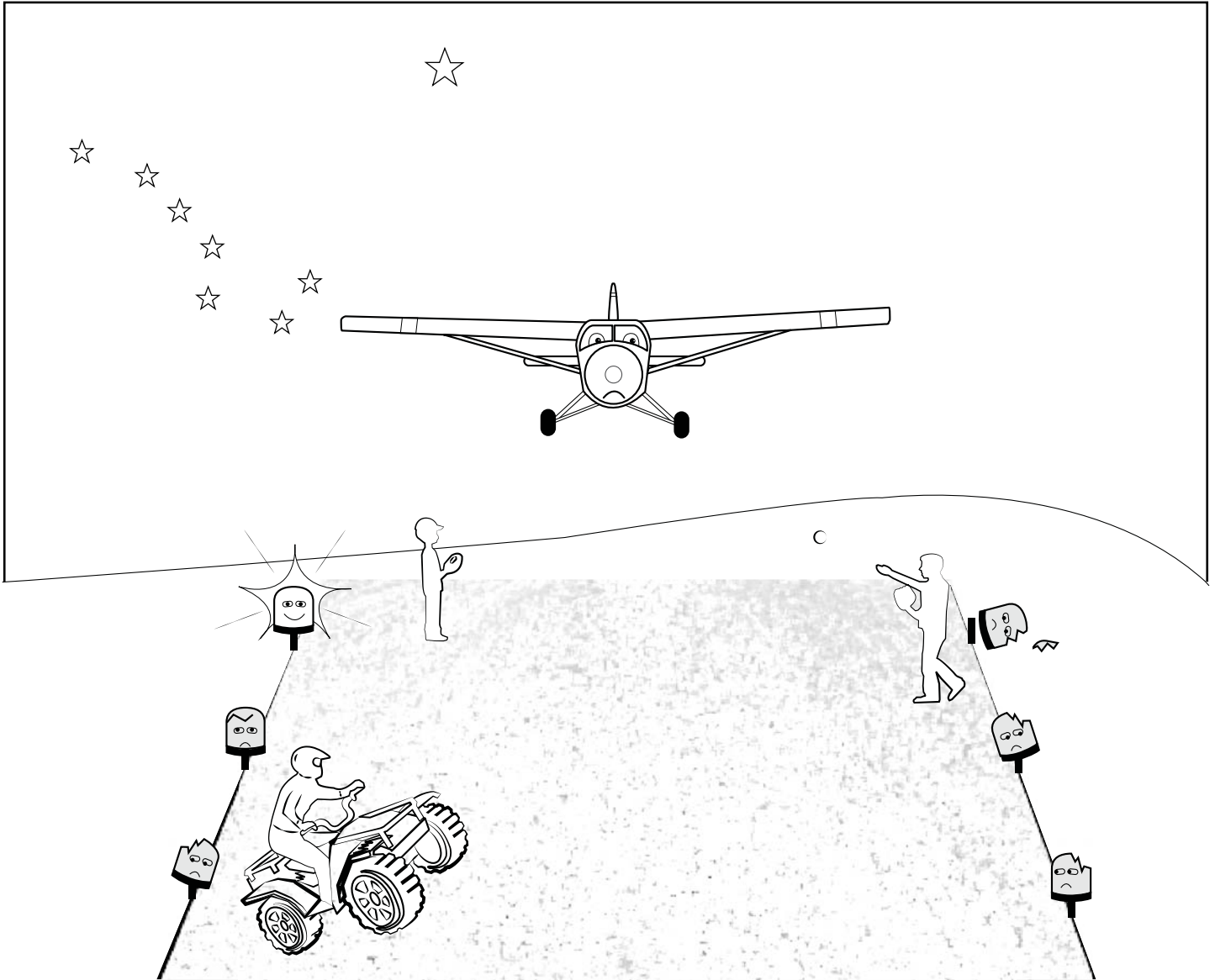
Willy flies passengers and delivers important supplies, such as groceries and medicine, to people living in villages.

As they approach The Village's airport for landing, Willy doesn't like what he sees.



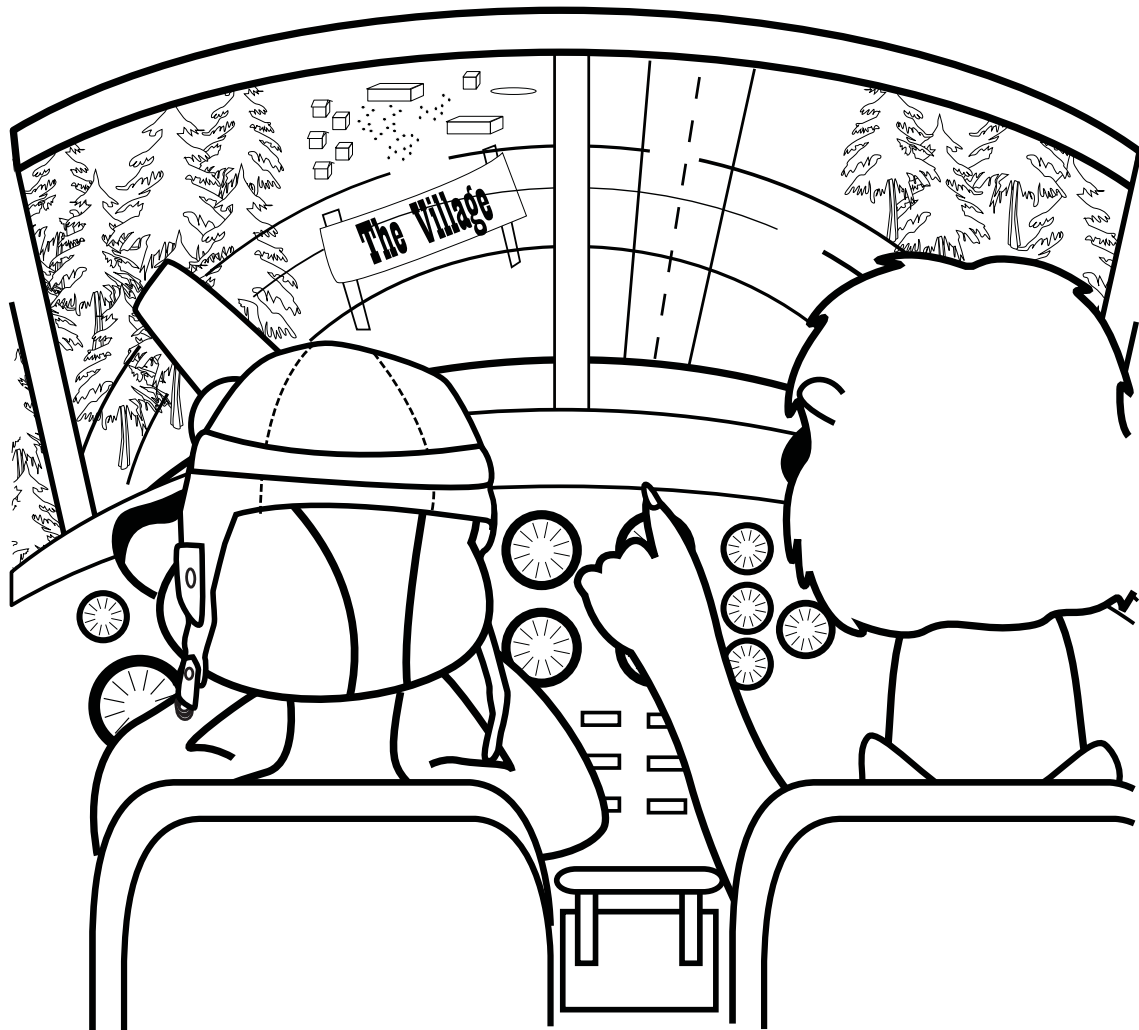

"That's not good," complains Otto. "It's really important I get home, and The Village really needs these supplies! I thought everyone knew that runways are only for airplanes!"

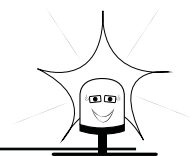
Willy nods and says, "It's getting really dark, but we will give it another try tomorrow."

When is it okay to be on a runway?

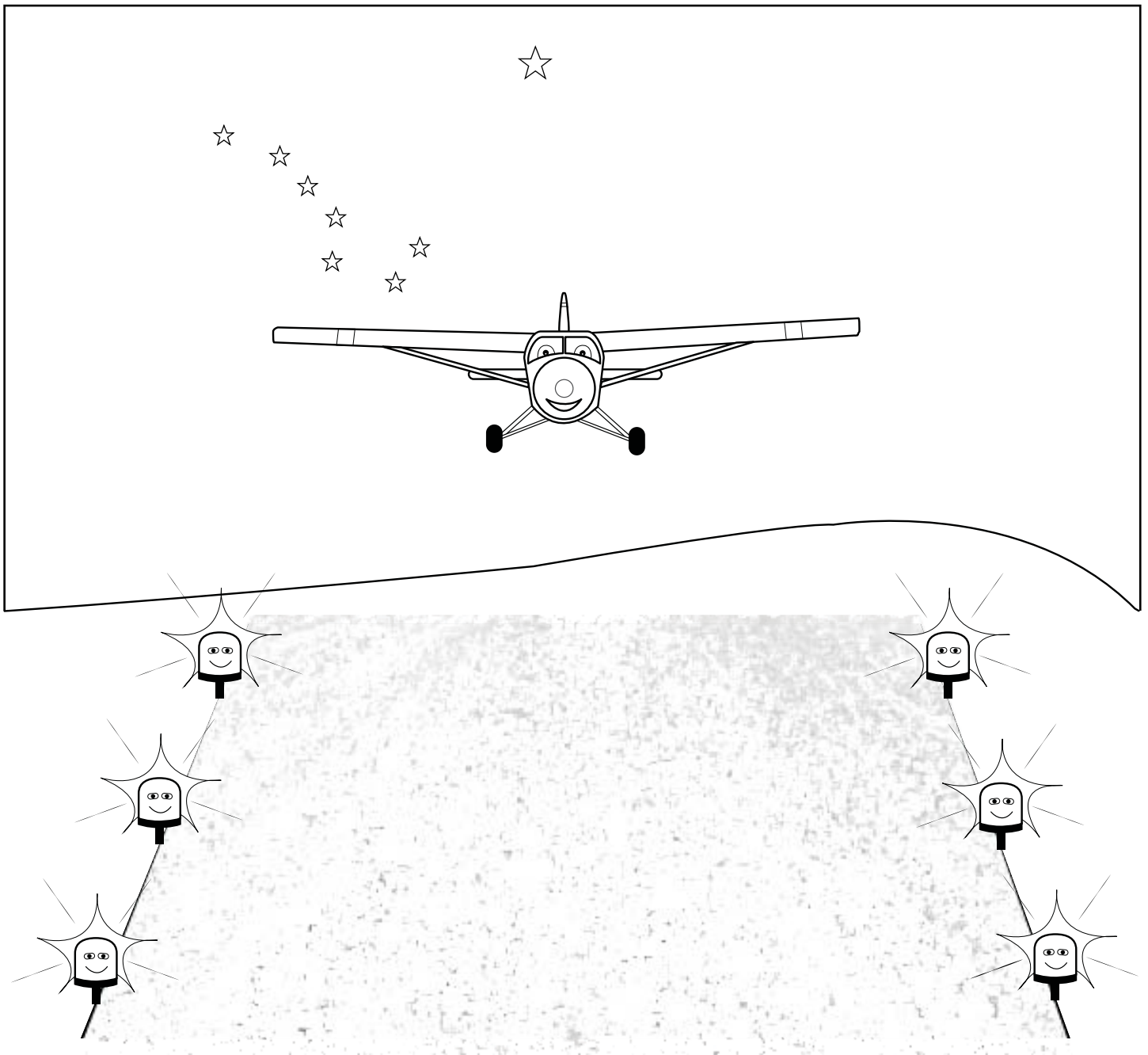

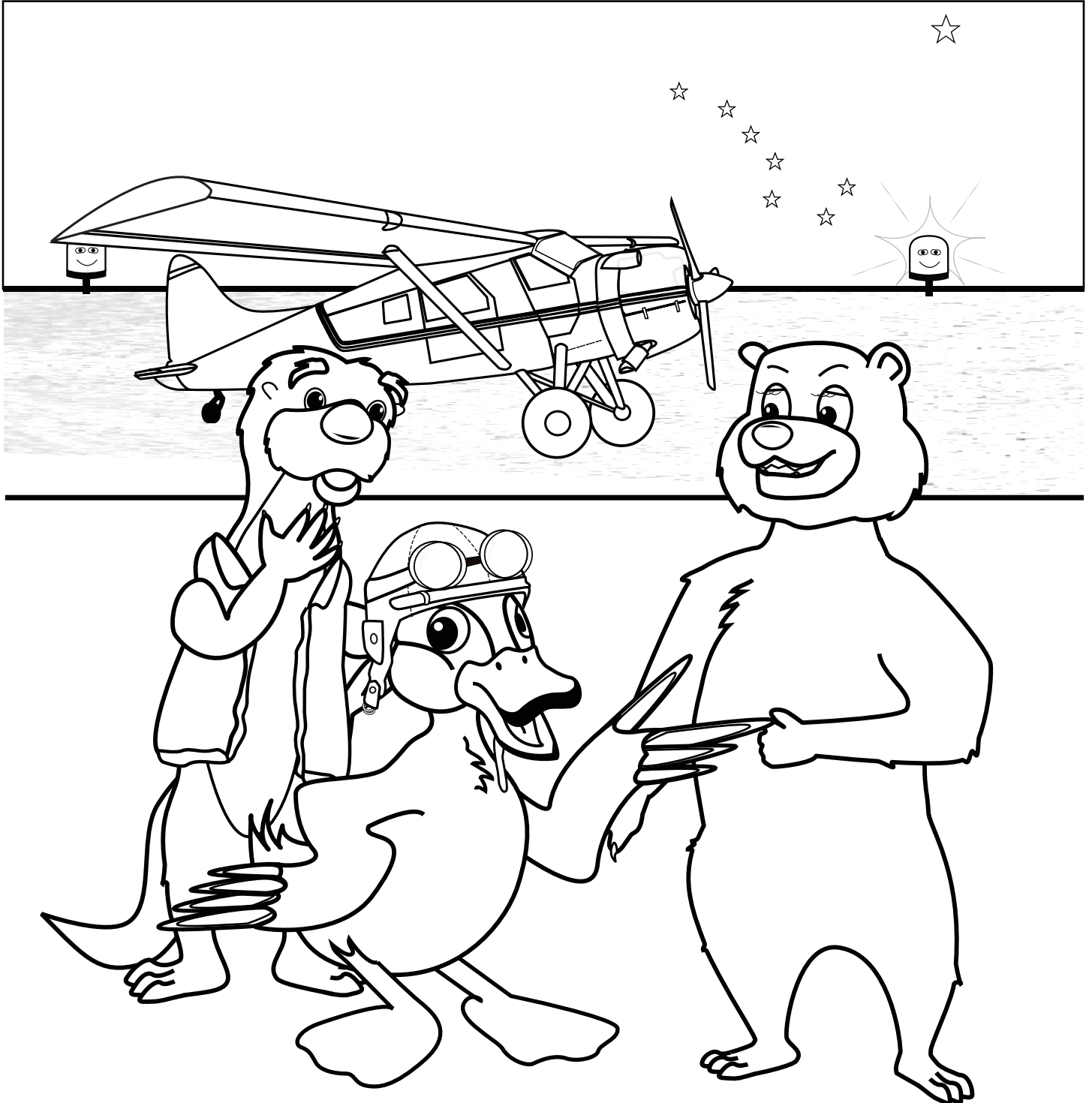
The next afternoon, as the sky begins to darken, Willy and Otto make their approach to The Village's runway.

"The runway is clear and well-lit!" declares Willy. "We are good to safely land!"

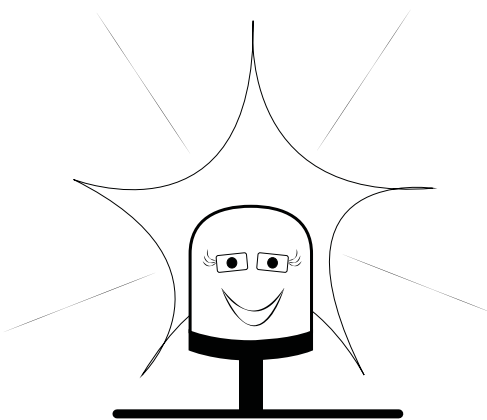

Otto smiles, knowing that he and The Village's important supplies have arrived safely home.



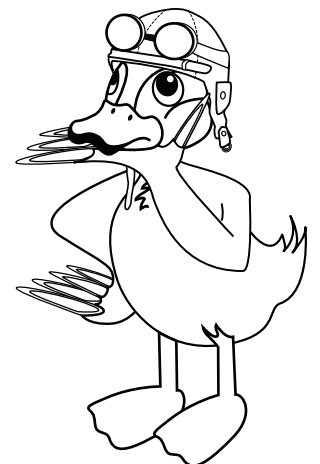
