Books, Transportation, and Personal expenses are variable, out-of-pocket costs that will not be included on your billing statement. These charges will vary by student. Loan fees are the average amount of loan fees incurred by all students for Federal Direct Loan funds during the 2021-22 academic year.

Most graduate students that complete a FAFSA are eligible for an Unsubsidized Direct Loan of \$20,500 per year. Additional funding, up to the full Cost of Attendance, less other financial aid can be obtained through the Graduate PLUS Loan. Graduate Assistantships are considered other sources of financial aid and can reduce initial loan amounts. If not attending full time, this budget will be prorated by the number of credits enrolled.
