Missouri State Standing Order for Naloxone

Updated: June 3, 2024

Section 195.206. RSMo, sanctions the Director of the Department of Health and Senior Services to authorize a Missouri licensed physician to issue a statewide standing order for an opioid antagonist. Pursuant to said section, I hereby authorize Heidi B. Miller, MD to issue such standing order.

This order and procedure shall remain in effect until June 2, 2025, or until DHSS issues an updated standing order. Always refer to https://health.mo.gov/data/opioids/pdf/naloxone-standing-order.pdf and refresh the webpage for the most up-to-date version.

This replaces all previous Missouri State Standing Orders for Naloxone, including the last one issued 8/22/2023.

Naloxone HCL Dispensing Protocol

Eligible Candidates

- Persons who voluntarily request naloxone and are at risk of experiencing an opioid-related drug overdose, including but not limited to:
 - Persons with current use of non-prescription opioids or other illicit substances, or persons with a history of such use
 - Persons with a history of opioid or other drug intoxication or overdose and/or recipients of emergency medical care for acute opioid or other drug poisoning
 - Persons with a high dose opioid prescription (>50 morphine mg equivalents per day) or persons co-prescribed any dose of opioids with benzodiazepines or other sedatives
 - Persons with an opioid prescription and known or suspected concurrent alcohol or other substance use, smoking, COPD or other respiratory illness, kidney dysfunction, liver disease, heart disease, or HIV/AIDS
 - Persons who have recently detoxified or been abstinent from opioids
 - Persons entering, participating in, or exiting treatment programs for substance use disorder or for pain management
 - Persons who may have difficulty accessing emergency medical services
 - Persons enrolled in prescription lock-in programs (which stipulate restrictions to a specific provider and/or specific pharmacy location)
 - Persons reentering the community after incarceration
- Persons who voluntarily request naloxone and are a family member, friend or other individual in the position to assist a person at risk of experiencing an opioid or other drug overdose.

Directions for Use	Call 911. Use one full spray in one nostril one time. Repeat every 2-3 minutes as needed if no or minimal response.	Call 911. Inject the entire contents of the vial IM/SC in shoulder or thigh. Repeat every 2-3 minutes as needed if no or minimal response.	Call 911. Inject the entire contents of the syringe IM/SC in shoulder or thigh. Repeat every 2-3 minutes as needed if no or minimal response.

Pharmacy Instructions to Process Refills	If a prescription has no refills remaining or is expired, there is no need to send a refill request; use the current standing order to generate a new prescription. If feasible with the pharmacy processing software: - Take precautions to assure that refills are automatically processed through this state standing order and not erroneously routed to Dr. Heidi B. Miller's own clinical practice location, which would lead to delays and patient privacy violations. Consider the following: a. Generate a separate prescriber profile for "Heidi Miller, MD – MO Standing Order - Chief Medical Officer of DHSS" or other similar description, and/or b. Add language to the prescription label or prescription record with one of the following alerts or similar communication: i. Dispensed pursuant to a MO state standing order, or ii. Refer to pharmacist for refills via MO standing order, or iii. Refer questions about refills to your pharmacist.

Cost	If any patient is unable to receive this naloxone prescription due to cost despite attempts to utilize insurance coverage or prescription coupons, then refer patient to this website to find free naloxone within their community: www.GetMissouriNaloxone.com		
Patient Education	 Every person dispensed naloxone under this standing order shall receive education regarding the risk factors of overdose, signs of an overdose, overdose response steps, proper use of naloxone, and need for the comprehensive substance use medical treatment. Offer recipient a list of local treatment resources for substance use disorder: www.nomodeaths.org/get-treatment (see Appendix A)
