The aim is to assist higher education leaders wishing to embed sustainable development concepts and principles in strategic planning, academic and organizational work.

<u>The High-Level Political Forum</u> (HLPF) is the yearly conference of the United Nations where governments, UN Agencies and civil society come together to discuss the achievements that have been made towards Agenda 2030. The theme this year for the largely virtual event is "Accelerated action and transformative pathways: realizing the decade of action and delivery for sustainable development". IAU has Consultative Status with the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) which enables participation in this High-Level event.
