 HB 629	ST. GERMAIN	FUNDS/FUNDING (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the deposit of revenues into the Transportation Trust Fund
 HB 671	ST. GERMAIN	PUBLIC CONTRACTS Authorizes the preference for the purchase of Louisiana products in public bid law to apply to purchases of fire fighting or rescue equipment
 HB 778	ST. GERMAIN	FUNDS/FUNDING Changes restrictions on the deposit of sales tax revenues related to motor vehicles into the Transportation Trust Fund and Transportation Mobility Fund
 HB 884	ST. GERMAIN	FUNDS/FUNDING Provides with regard to dedications of certain excess mineral revenues and deposits into the Budget Stabilization Fund
 HB 979	ST. GERMAIN	TRANSPORTATION Provides for the creation of the Louisiana Transportation Infrastructure Bank
