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| HCR 51 | HODGES | TRANSPORTATION Creates a task force to study and make recommendations on actions necessary to complete the construction of the Comite River Diversion Project |
| HCR 70 | HARRISON | U.S. CONSTITUTION Applies to congress under U.S. Const. Art. V to call a convention of the states to propose a U.S. constitutional amendment to require a balanced budget |
| HB 143 | RICHARD | LEGISLATORS Prohibits a former legislator from being appointed to or employed in any position in state government for a period of two years following the termination of his service as a legislator |
| HB 161 | THIBAUT | LOBBYING Requires notification and reporting relative to certain communications made for the purpose of influencing the passage or defeat of legislation |
| HB 190 | MILLER | ETHICS/NEPOTISM Removes a nepotism exception for certain health professionals in a parish with a population of between four hundred thousand and four hundred forty thousand |
| HB 265 | MILLER | CAMPAIGN FINANCE Prohibits the expenditure of campaign funds on certain specified items |
| HB 277 | GEYMANN | ETHICS Provides for additional ethical standards for members of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, the state superintendent of education, and related persons |
| HB 374 | GEYMANN | BESE (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the election of all members of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education |
| HB 406 | BURNS, TIM | ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE Requires the consideration of certain provider impact issues and issuance of a provider impact statement prior to the adoption, amendment, or repeal of rules by a state agency |

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| HB 452 | TALBOT | ETHICS Prohibits public servants from engaging in certain activities with public funds and assets |
| HB 459 | ARNOLD | ETHICS Allows an immediate family member of a legislator to lobby the legislature under certain circumstances |
| HB 739 | LANDRY, NANCY | LOBBYING Provides relative to certain legislative groups and lobbyist expenditure reports |
| HB 764 | PEARSON | INSURANCE/HEALTH Provides for the licensing and regulation of health insurance navigators and similar individuals and entities |
| HB 870 | RICHARD | ETHICS Prohibits certain transactions involving charter schools |
| HB 1062 | HOFFMANN | SNAP/FOOD STAMPS Provides for a task force to make recommendations concerning electronic issuance of SNAP benefits |
| HB 1079 | BURNS, TIM | CAMPAIGN FINANCE Provides relative to the reporting of expenditures of campaign funds |
| HB 1167 | ARNOLD | CIVIL SERVICE/MUNICIPAL Provides with respect to testing for civil service entrance and promotion for certain city civil service employees |
| HB 1211 | BURNS, TIM | ELECTIONS Provides relative to precinct changes and annexations for election purposes |
