_____	HB 1208	PIERRE	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Requires that students attending a charter school be provided free transportation in certain parishes.
_____	HB 1243	HODGES	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Provides conditions and prohibitions relative to approval of certain charter school proposals
_____	HB 1253	LANDRY, NANCY	SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES Provides relative to the powers of local public school boards and superintendents with respect to extended sick leave for school bus drivers, teachers, and school employees
