HB 52	GREEN	REGISTRARS OF VOTERS Provides relative to the filing of oaths and bonds by registrars of voters
НВ 576	WILLARD	VOTERS/VOTING Provides with respect to maintaining voter registration lists
SB 36	BERNARD	ELECTION CODE Provides for the acceptance of a notice of candidacy. (gov sig)
SB 140	REESE	INTERNET Requires certain offices to report cyber incidents to secretary of state. (8/1/20)
SB 173	BERNARD	ELECTION CODE Requires a notice to be posted upon the withdrawal or disqualification of a candidate's name that remains on the ballot. (8/1/20)
