14 2020, Transportation Special Opening Meeting

21 Item RR-1 concerns the City of Chenoa's
22 Petition to install a bicycle and pedestrian

2 efforts to establish the path to be too costly. The
3 Order grants the City's Motion to Dismiss and
4 cancels the project.
