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1 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hi. Good 2 afternoon. I have 1:00 o'clock on my phone. 3 Are we ready to proceed in Chicago? COMMISSIONER KIMBREL: We are. 4 5 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Thank you. 6 Under the Open Meetings Act, I call the 7 February 18, 2020, Regular Opening Meeting to order. 8 Commissioners Bocanegra, Carrigan, and 9 Oliva are with me in Springfield, and Commissioner 10 Kimbrel is in Chicago. We have a guorum. 11 We have no requests to speak; so we will 12 move on to our Transportation Agenda. 13 There are no edits to the January 21, 14 2020, Transportation Special Opening Meeting 15 Minutes. 16 Are there any objections to approving 17 the Minutes? 18 (No response.) 19 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 20 Minutes are approved. 21 Item RR-1 concerns the City of Chenoa's 22 Petition to install a bicycle and pedestrian 23 crossing over a rail track. The City recently filed 24 a Motion to Voluntarily Dismiss the matter. The

City determines the efforts -- determined the 1 2 efforts to establish the path to be too costly. The 3 Order grants the City's Motion to Dismiss and cancels the project. 4 5 Are there any objections to approving 6 the Order? 7 (No response.) 8 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 9 Order is approved. 10 Items RR-2 through RR-4 concern 11 Stipulated Agreements regarding various public safety improvement projects at railway crossings. 12 13 The Orders authorize the construction or extend 14 project completion dates and approve project costs 15 apportionment. 16 Are there any objections to considering 17 these items together and approving the Orders? 18 (No response.) 19 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 20 Orders are approved. 21 Under our Motor Carrier items, Item MC-1 22 and MC-2 concern Applications for Commercial 23 Relocation Towing License Renewals.
