1 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Under the Open
2 Meetings Act and in accordance with the Governor's
3 executive orders, I call the November 5, 2020,
4 regular opening meeting to order.

5 Before we proceed and for clarity of
6 the record, I would ask everyone to state their name
7 before speaking and to speak slowly and clearly so
8 that the court reporter can capture everything that
9 is said.

10 The court reporter is in Springfield
11 with commissioner Kimbrel and Carrigan. So if the
12 court reporter is unable to hear us, just wave, and
13 then perhaps Mr. Kimbrel or Carrigan can speak up
14 and let us know.

15 (Wherein, a brief recess was taken.)

16 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Then we are
17 going to move on to our agenda. Under our
18 transportation agenda, there are no
19 transportation minutes to approve.

20 Under our railroad items, item RR-1
21 through RR-3 concern various public safety
22 improvement projects at railway crossings. The
23 orders authorize the project construction or
24 extend project timelines and approve project

1 costs apportionment.

2 Are there any objections to
3 considering these items together and approving
4 the orders?

5 Hearing none, the orders are
6 approved.

7 Under our Motor Carrier Items, item
8 MC-1 concerns application for a commercial
9 relocater's license. The order grants the
10 certificate, finding that the applicant meets
11 the requirements.

12 Are there any objections to
13 approving the order?

14 Hearing none, the order is approved.

15 Under our collateral recovery items,
16 item CR-1 concerns an application for a Class E
17 recovery permit. The commission staff has
18 reviewed the application and finds that the
19 applicant meets the requirements. The order
20 grants the permit.

21 Are there any objections to
22 approving the order?

23 Hearing none, the order is approved.

1 agenda, moving up to our public utility agenda.
