1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Under the Open Meetings
2 Act, I now call the February 8th, 2024 Regular Open
3 Meeting to order.

4 Commissioners Carrigan, McCabe and
5 Paradis are with me in Springfield. Commissioner
6 Reddick is joining us from Chicago. We have a quorum.

7 There are no requests to speak today, so
8 we will start today's meeting with a Public Utilities
9 Agenda followed by our Transportation Agenda.

10 (Whereupon the Public Utilities Regular
11 Open Meeting was held.)

12 Moving on to the Transportation Agenda.
13 There are edits to the January 31st Regular Open
14 Meeting Minutes. Are there any objections to approving
15 the Minutes as edited?

16 (No verbal response.)

17 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
18 Minutes are approved as edited.

19 Turning to Railroad Items. Items RR-1
20 through RR-4 concern various public safety improvement
21 projects at railway crossings in Illinois. The Orders
22 extend deadlines, approved projects, and approved

1 project cost apportionments.

2 Are there any objections to considering
3 these items together and approving the Orders?

4 (No verbal response.)

5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
6 Orders are approved.

7 Moving on to Motor Carrier items. Item
8 MC-1 concerns an application for a Commercial Vehicle
9 Relocator's towing license. The Order grants the
10 application, finding that the applicant meets the
11 requirements.

12 Are there any objections to approving
13 the Order?

14 (No verbal response.)

15 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order
16 is approved.

17 Item MC-2 concerns a Stipulated
18 Agreement regarding alleged violations of the Illinois
19 Commercial Transportation Law. The Order accepts the
20 Stipulated Agreement.

21 Are there any objections to approving
22 the order?

1 (No verbal response.)

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order
3 is approved.

4 Moving on to Administrative Matters.

5 Item AM-1 concerns a Life Saving Award Resolution.

6 This resolution recognizes ICC Police Officer Scott
7 Grimm for his actions on September 7, 2023.

8 Officer Grimm was flagged down by a
9 construction worker who pointed him in the direction of
10 a single vehicle crash. Upon approaching the vehicle,
11 Officer Grimm found the driver unresponsive and
12 struggling to breathe. Officer Grimm relied on his
13 training and deployed Narcan due to the driver's
14 condition. After the first dose failed to revive the
15 driver, another dose was administered by Officer Grimm.
16 Due to Officer Grimm's dedication to duty and
17 willingness to render medical aid, one of our citizens
18 is alive today.

19 Are there any objections to recognizing
20 Officer Grimm through the adoption of this Life-Saving
21 Award Resolution?

22 (No verbal response.)

1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
2 resolution is adopted.

3 I'd like to ask Officer Grimm to come
4 forward, and we want to present him with this award.

5 (Chairman Scott greets Officer Grimm at
6 the front of the bench, shakes his
7 hand and presents the award to Officer
8 Grimm.)

9 I told Officer Grimm he had the ability
10 to make up to a 45-minutes speech if he wanted to, and
11 he assured me he wanted to say absolutely nothing. But
12 we really appreciate your dedication to public service,
13 Officer, and thank you very much. And congratulations.
14 And thank you on behalf of all of us. Thank you.

15 This concludes our agenda for today.

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Judge Teague Kingsley,
17 do we have any other matters to come before the
18 Commission?

19 JUDGE KINGLSEY: No, Mr. Chairman.

20 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Thank you. Do the
21 Commissioners have any other business to discuss?

22 (No verbal response.)

1 If there are no further comments and
2 without objections, this meeting is adjourned. Thank
3 you.
