CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Good morning, everyone. Under the Open Meetings Act, I call the August 16, 2023, Regular Open Meeting to order. Commissioners Carrigan, McCabe, Reddick and Paradis are with me in Springfield. We have a quorum.

Moving on to our Transportation Agenda, under Railroad Items, Items RR-1 and RR-2 concern petitions for authority to establish a new highway/rail at-grade crossing and a stipulated agreement to improve public safety, both in the Village of Bedford Park. The Orders approve the projects, each project's cost apportionment, and project deadlines.

Moving on to Motor Carrier Items, Item MC-1 concerns an application to transfer a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to

5 motor carrier services requested.

19 Item MC-4 concerns application for an
20 Operator Employment Permit. The Order grants the
21 permit, finding that the applicant meets the

5 Items MC-5 through MC-7 concern
6 applications for renewal of commercial vehicle
7 relocator's licenses. The Orders grant the

14 Item MC-8 concerns a stipulated
15 agreement regarding alleged violations of the
