1 CHAIR SCOTT: Under the Open Meetings  
2 Act, I call the August 3rd, 2023 Regular Open Meeting to  
3 order. Commissioners Carrigan, McCabe, Reddick, and  
4 Paradis are with me in Chicago, we have a quorum.

5 We have four requests to speak today, Ms.  
6 Oblinger-Hammond, Mr. Nat Steinsultz, Mr. Brandon  
7 Hurley, and Mr. Brayden Misiolak. If I mispronounced  
8 anyone's name I apologize. We will hear these speakers  
9 in order beginning with Ms. Oblinger-Hammond. Under 2  
10 Illinois Administrative Code Section 1700.10, any person  
11 desiring to address the Commission shall be allowed up  
12 to three minutes. Only one person may speak on behalf  
13 of any organization. Please note that the Commission  
14 will not respond directly to your comments.

15 Ms. Oblinger-Hammond, you have three  
16 minutes. Please note the timer to my right will start  
17 once you begin. You may begin, but please state and  
18 spell your name for the court reporter.

19 MS. OBLINGER-HAMMOND: My name is Ripley,  
20 R-I-P-L-E-Y; Oblinger, O-B-L-I-N-G-E-R; Hammond,  
21 H-A-M-M-O-N-D. On July 14, my car was stolen and held  
22 for \$6,000 in insurance money for the two days it spent

1 on Michael Warren's tow truck company's lot; Take Me  
2 Home Towing. Where is the lot you may ask, I won't  
3 spend my three minutes boring you with the four  
4 different addresses that were given to myself, the  
5 police, and my insurance by Michael Warren.

6           However, after checking my own vehicle without  
7 the help of Mike or Take Me Home Towing, it was located  
8 at 13138 Genoa Avenue in Blue Island, Illinois. After  
9 filing a stolen police report, speaking to Mike with  
10 police right next to me, and countless hours on the  
11 phone with the news and my insurance, my insurance was  
12 able to pay the \$6,000 and pick up my vehicle at an  
13 address I'm still unaware of.

14           I'm one of the few who gets their vehicles  
15 back within 48 hours after finding out that Mike was  
16 going to try to take my car. But speaking here today,  
17 isn't about the insurance fraud, lying to police,  
18 causing my anxiety to spike, my car being totaled with  
19 more damage to the vehicle after being in Mike's  
20 possession, or even about the anger, and even the  
21 forgiveness I have in my heart for Mike.

22           You see Michael Warren's license for Take Me

1 Home Towing was revoked three weeks before the tow for  
2 having a standing 33 citations and not paying fines. I  
3 thank and applaud you for this; however, here is the  
4 issue that I hope can be solved. Michael Warren was the  
5 previous owner of a tow truck company called, Tow Pros  
6 Incorporated. Which had its license revoked and was  
7 shut down after vehicles were removed from his illegal  
8 lot.

9 Michael Warren then re-branded, started taking  
10 home towing and gained another license to start this tow  
11 business: Take Me Home Towing. This is the issue,  
12 Michael Warren should have never been granted another  
13 license for operating a tow truck company. I've been  
14 grateful enough to speak with many people on this  
15 journey, one, including an ICC police officer. I asked  
16 him what happens when Mike operates his company with a  
17 revoked license, in which he did to me.

18 I was told, "He will get fined \$1,000 a day if  
19 he doesn't respond". Okay. And then what if his  
20 license was revoked because he didn't pay fines does he  
21 get arrested? "No". For my final thoughts to you,  
22 people can no longer look me up -- look up, Take Me Home

1 Towing without seeing my article, "Woman can't find  
2 vehicle after being towed".

3           Therefore, I'm sure Mike will want to re-brand  
4 and try for another license in which he may gain unless  
5 something changes. How many chances will Mike get  
6 before someone says no to him? I ask that Michael  
7 Warren does not receive another license to operate tow  
8 truck company, and his current business of Take Me Home  
9 Towing is shut down and vehicles are ceased from his  
10 property; including at a 13138 Genoa avenue and 8900  
11 south Chicago. Also, to reconsider how many license an  
12 individual can receive when they have licenses that are  
13 already -- that have already been revoked.

14           Lastly, as I was reporting my vehicle -- my  
15 stolen vehicle to the Forest District Police, another  
16 man walked in who I didn't know. The police asked, how  
17 can I help you, sir? I turned around. He stated, "my  
18 car was stolen by a company called Take Me Home Towing  
19 two months ago".

20           CHAIR SCOTT: Thank you very much for your  
21 comments Ms. Ripley -- Ms. Oblinger-Hammond; thank you  
22 very much. We appreciate it.

1           Third, we'll hear from Mr. Hurley who I  
2 believe will be presenting remotely. Mr. Hurley you  
3 will have three minutes, at the end my advisor will have  
4 a timer and I'll indicate when your time is up. Mr.  
5 Hurley you may begin but first spell your name for the  
6 Court Reporter.

7           MR. RAZOR: Gentlemen, I don't believe Mr.  
8 Hurley ever connected.

9           CHAIR SCOTT: Okay. Very good. Then fourth  
10 we will hear from Mr. Misiolek and again, I apologize if  
11 I've mispronounced your name; he will be presenting  
12 remotely. You have three minutes, we have a timer at  
13 the end and we'll let you know when your time has  
14 expired. And again please spell your name for the court  
15 reporter and correct me if I have your name wrong.

16          MR. RAZOR: No.

17          CHAIR SCOTT: Okay. All right. This  
18 concludes our requests to speak.

19          We will now move onto our Transportation  
20 agenda.

21          There are no edits to the June 29, 2023  
22 Regular Open Meeting Minutes. Are there any objections

1 to approving the minutes?

2 (No verbal response.)

3 CHAIR SCOTT: Hearing none, the minutes are  
4 approved.

5 Items RR-1 through RR-7 concern various public  
6 safety improvement projects at railway crossings. The  
7 order approve the projects, extend deadlines, and  
8 approve project cost apportionment.

9 Are there any objections to considering these  
10 items together and approving the orders?

11 (No verbal response.)

12 CHAIR SCOTT: Hearing none, the orders are  
13 approved.

14 Moving on to our Motor Carriers Items.

15 Item MC-1 concerns an application for a new  
16 Commercial Vehicle Relocator's license. The order  
17 grants the application, finding that the applicant meets  
18 the requirements.

19 Are there any objections to approving the  
20 order?

21 (No verbal response.)

22 CHAIR SCOTT: Hearing none, the order is

1 approved.

2 Items MC-2 through MC-4 concern applications  
3 for an operator employment permit. The orders grant the  
4 permits, finding that the applicant's meet the  
5 requirements.

6 Are there any objections to considering these  
7 items together and approving the orders?

8 (No verbal response.)

9 CHAIR SCOTT: Hearing none, the orders are  
10 approved.

11 Item MC-5 concerns an application for renewal  
12 of a Commercial relocation towing license. The  
13 applicant failed to complete a renewal application with  
14 the necessary information, we required by statute and  
15 Commission rules. The order sets the matter for  
16 hearings as prescribed by section 401 of the Illinois  
17 Commercial Relocation of Trespassing Vehicles Law.

18 Are there any objections to approving the  
19 order?

20 (No verbal response.)

21 CHAIR SCOTT: Hearing none, the order is  
22 approved.



1           Item MC-6 and MC-7 concern stipulated  
2 agreements of alleged violations of the Illinois  
3 Transportation Law. The orders accept the stipulated  
4 agreements.

6 items together and approving the orders?

8           CHAIR SCOTT: Hearing none, the orders are  
9 approved.

10           Moving onto our Collateral Recovery items.

11           Item CR-1 concerns an application for a class.  
12 "E" recovery permit. Commission Staff has reviewed the  
13 application and recommends granting the permit. The  
14 order grants the permit.

18           CHAIR SCOTT: Hearing none, the order is  
19 approved.
