1 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Under the Open  
2 Meetings Act, I call the April 21, 2022, Regular  
3 Open Meeting to order. Commissioners Bocanegra,

16 Under our Railroad items, Items RR-1

20 Agreements, authorize the projects' construction,  
21 extend projects' deadlines, and approve cost  
22 apportionment.
