2 agenda.

3 (TRANSPORTATION AGENDA)

4 There are no edits to the November 2
5 Transportation Regular Open Meeting Minutes. Are there
6 any objections to approving the Minutes?

7 Hearing none, the Minutes are approved.

8 Items RR-1 through RR-4 concern various
9 improvement projects at railway crossings. The orders
10 approve the projects, the project deadlines, and the
11 cost apportionment. Are there any objections to
12 considering these items together and approving the
13 Orders?

14 Hearing none, the Orders are approved.

15 Item RR-5 concerns an Application from
16 MCC Network Services seeking a Commission
17 determination. MCC Network Services seeks
18 determination that its proposed underground
19 installation of fiber optic cable lines will not create
20 a dangerous condition or interrupt services at a
21 railroad crossing on property owned by Decatur
22 Junction.

1 The Order finds that, 1) the proposed
2 lines are cable television facilities under Section
3 11-42-11.1(F) of the Illinois Municipal Code: 2) MCC
4 Network Services has complied with the requirements of
5 the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law by providing
6 Decatur Junction with written notice of its intent to
7 install these fiber cable lines; (3) Decatur Junction
8 should, within 30 days of the Order, investigate,
9 determine, and notify MCC Network Services if the
10 proposed installation would create a dangerous
11 situation. And 4) the objection to the Decatur
12 Junction of the application should be denied. Are
13 there any objections to approving the Order?

14 Hearing none, the order is approved.

15 MOTOR CARRIERS AGENDA

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Moving on to Motor
17 Carriers items. Items MC1 through MC-3 concern
18 applications for new Household Goods Property Motor
19 Carrier Authority. The Orders grant the certificates
20 finding that the applicants meet the requirements.

22 these items together and approving the Orders?
