

1 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Under the Open Meetings
2 Act, and in accordance with the Governor's
3 executive orders, I call the November 18, 2020,
4 Regular Open Meeting to order.

5 Before we proceed, and for the
6 clarity of the record, I would ask everyone to
7 state their name before speaking and to speak
8 slowly and clearly so that the court reporter can
9 capture everything that is said.

10 I checked that all Commissioners
11 are with us and we have a quorum.

12 We have no requests to speak, so we
13 are moving on to our agenda.

14 Under our Transportation Agenda:
15 There are no edits to the October 28, 2020,
16 Transportation Regular Open Meeting Minutes.

17 Are there any objections to
18 approving the minutes?

19 (No verbal response.)

20 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
21 minutes are approved.

22 Items RR-1 through RR-6 concern

1 various public safety improvement projects at
2 railway crossings. The orders authorize the
3 project construction or extend project timelines
4 and approve project costs apportionment.

5 Are there any objections to
6 considering these items together and approving the
7 orders?

8 (No verbal response.)

9 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
10 orders are approved.

11 Under our Motor Carrier items:
12 Items MC-1 through MC-3 concern applications for
13 renewal of Commercial Relocator's License. The
14 orders renew the certificates, finding that the
15 applicants meet the requirements.

16 Are there any objections to
17 considering these items together and approving the
18 orders?

19 (No verbal response.)

20 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
21 orders are approved.

22 Under our Collateral Recovery

1 Items: Items CR-1 and CR-2 concern applications
2 for Class E Recovery Permits. The Commission Staff
3 has reviewed the applications and find that the
4 applicants meet the requirements. The order grants
5 the permit.

6 Are there objections to considering
7 these items together and approving the orders?

8 (No verbal response.)

9 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
10 orders are approved.

11 Under our Administrative Matters:
12 Item AM-1 concerns the Commission 2020 Annual
13 Report to the Governor and the General Assembly on
14 the Transportation Regulatory Fund. The annual
15 report is required by the Illinois Commercial
16 Transportation Law. The report contains
17 information on all expenditures and all funds
18 deposited in the Transportation Regulatory Fund
19 during the 2020 fiscal year.

20 Are there any objections to
21 approving the order?

22 (No verbal response.)

2 report is approved.
