Page 2 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Good morning. I have 1 2 11:30. I call the open meeting -- under the Open Meetings Act, I call the June 1st, 2023, Regular Open 3 4 Meeting to order. Commissioners Carrigan, McCabe, Reddick, and 5 Paradis are with me in Springfield. We have a quorum. 6 7 We are going to our transportation agenda. There are no edits to the April 20, 2023, 8 and the May 4, 2023, Regular Open Meeting minutes. 9 10 Are there any objections to approving the 11 minutes? 12 (No verbal response.) 13 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 14 minutes are approved. 15 Items RR-1 through RR-10 concern various 16 public CT improvement projects at railway crossings. The orders approve the projects, extend deadlines, and 17 18 approve projects cost apportionment. Are there any objections to considering 19 these items together and approving the orders? 20 21 (No verbal response.) 22 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders 23 are approved.
