1 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Under the Open 2 Meetings Act I call the June 9, 2022, Regular Open 3 Meeting to order. I am in the Springfield office 4 with Commissioners Kimbrel, Carrigan and McCabe, 5 and Commissioner Bocanegra is in the Chicago 6 office. 7 We have a quorum. We have no requests to speak. 9 We are moving onto our Transportation There are edits to the May 12th, 2022, 10 Agenda. 11 Regular Open Meeting minutes. Are there any 12 objections to approving the minutes as edited? 13 (No response.) 14 Hearing none, the CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI:

CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the minutes are approved.

Under our Railroad items, Items RR-1
through RR-15 concern public safety improvement
projects at railway crossings across the state.
The orders approve the terms of the stipulated
agreements, authorize the projects' construction,
set project deadlines, approve cost apportionment,
grant time extensions and authorize additional

Are there any objections to considering 3 these items together and approving the Orders? 4 (No response.) 5 Hearing none, the CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: 6 orders are approved. 7 Under our Motor Carrier items, MC-1 8 concerns the application for a new household goods property mover authority and public carrier 9 10 The Order grants a temporary one-year certificate. 11 certificate finding that the applicant meets the 12 requirements. 13 Are there any objections to approving the 14 Order? 15 (No response.) 16 Hearing none, the CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: 17 Order is approved. 18 Item MC-2 concerns an application for 19 transfer of household goods property motor carrier

authority. The Order grants the transfer of authority finding that the applicant meets the requirements.

1 Are there any objections to approving the 2 Order? 3 (No response.) 4 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 5 Order is approved. 6 Items MC-3 through MC-6 concern 7 applications for new household goods property mover 8 authority and public carrier certificates. In each 9 docket the applicant has failed to enter a 10 substitute attorney appearance, and in each docket staff filed a motion to dismiss indicating that the 11 12 respective applicant has failed to supplement the 13 record and move that the matter be marked as heard 14 and taken. The Orders dismiss the applications 15 without prejudice. 16 Are there any objections to considering 17 these items together and approving the Orders? 18 (No response.) 19 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 20 Orders are approved. 21 Item MC-7 concerns a stipulated settlement 22 agreement concerning the alleged violations of the

1 Illinois Commercial Transportation Law. 2. On April 6 of 2022, the Commission 3 Transportation Division's Office of Transportation 4 Counsel issued a notice of alleged violation and 5 opportunity to settle alleging Ramsey Excavating 6 had performed intrastate for-hire transportation 7 without authority. After being served, Respondent 8 initiated settlement negotiations with the Office 9 of Transportation Counsel of the Commission. 10 negotiations resulted in a tentative settlement 11 agreement. The Order approves the settlement 12 agreement which includes the assessment of a civil 13 penalty. 14 Are there any objections to approving the 15 Order? 16 (No response.) 17 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 18 Order is approved. 19 This concludes our Transportation Agenda. 20 (Whereupon the above matter was adjourned.) 21
