1 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Okay. We're going to
2 now move on to our Transportation agenda.

3 Under the Open Meetings Act, I call the
4 March 4, 2020, Special Open Meeting to order.
5 Commissioners Carrigan and Kimbrel are with me in
6 Springfield. Commissioners Bocanegra and Oliva are
7 joining us from Chicago. We have a quorum.

8 There are edits to the February 5th, 2020,
9 Transportation Special Open Meeting minutes. There
10 are no edits to the February 18th, 2020,
11 Transportation Special Open Meeting minutes.

12 Are there any objections to approving the
13 minutes as edited?

14 (No response.)

15 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
16 minutes are approved.

17 Under our Railroad items, items RR-1 through
18 RR-5 concern stipulated agreements regarding various
19 public safety improvement projects at railway
20 crossings. The Orders authorize the construction and
21 approve project cost apportionment.

22 Are there any objections to considering
23 these items together and approving the Orders?

24 (No response.)

1 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Orders
2 are approved.

3 Under our Motor Carriers items, MC -- item
4 MC-1 concerns application for an operator employment
5 permit. The Order grants the permit, finding that
6 the applicant meets the requirements.

7 Are there any objections to approving the
8 Order?

9 (No response.)

10 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Order
11 is approved.

12 Items MC-2 and MC-3 concern applications for
13 Common Carrier certificates to transport household
14 goods. The Orders grant the certificates, finding
15 that the applicants meet the requirements.

16 Are there any objections to considering
17 these items together and approving the Orders?

18 (No response.)

19 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Orders
20 are approved.

21 Item MC-4 concerns an application for
22 renewal of a Commercial Relocation Towing license.
23 The Order grants the renewal, finding that the
24 applicant meets the requirements.

1 Are there any objections to approving the
2 Order?

3 (No response.)

4 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Order
5 is approved.

6 Under Collateral Recovery items, item CR-1
7 concerns an application for a Class E recovery
8 permit. The Order grants the permit, finding that
9 the applicant meets the requirements.

10 Are there any objections to approving the
11 Order?

12 (No response.)

13 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Order
14 is approved.

15 Under Administrative Matters, item AM-1
16 amends the Commission resolution adopted on
17 January 21st of 2020, in which the Commission
18 established a Motor Carrier Employee Board. The
19 amended resolution updates the delegated functions of
20 the Board. The amended resolution supercedes any
21 previous resolutions delegating functions to the
22 Motor Carrier Employee Board, the review and
23 examination program or staff.

24 Are there any objections to adopting the

1 amended resolution?

2 (No response.)

3 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
4 amended resolution is adopted.

5 Item AM-2 concerns a Commission resolution
6 pursuant to section 18C-1205 of the Illinois
7 Commercial Transportation law that appoints
8 additional persons to the Merit Advisory Board for
9 the purpose of interviewing and recommending
10 candidates for positions as the Commission police
11 officers.

12 Are there any objections to adopting the
13 resolution?

14 (No response.)

15 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
16 resolution is adopted.
