1 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: We are moving onto our
2 Transportation Agenda.

3 There are no edits to the April 21,
4 2022, Transportation Regular Open Meeting Minutes.

5 Are there any objections to approving
6 the Minutes?

7 (No verbal response.)

8 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Minutes are
9 approved.

10 Under our Railroad Items, Items RR-1
11 through RR-6 concerns public safety improvement
12 projects at railway crossings across the state. The
13 orders approve the terms of the stipulated agreements,
14 authorize the projects' construction, authorize
15 preliminary engineering and land acquisition
16 activities, sets projects' deadlines, and approve cost
17 apportionment.

18 Are there any objections to considering
19 these items together and approving the orders?

20 (No verbal response.)

21 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders are
22 approved.

23 Under our Motor Carrier Items,
24 Item MC-1 concerns an application for renewal of a

1 commercial relocation towing license. The order grants
2 the renewal, finding that the applicant meets the
3 requirements.

4 Are there any objections to approving
5 the order?

6 (No verbal response.)

7 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order is
8 approved.

9 Item MC-2 through MC-5 concern
10 stipulated settlement agreements for alleged violations
11 of the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law. The
12 order accepts the stipulated agreements.

13 Are there any objections to considering
14 these items together and approving the orders?

15 (No verbal response.)

16 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders are
17 approved.

18 Under our Petitions for Rehearing,
19 Item PR-1 concerns LB Andersen Land Holding's motion to
20 reopen Docket No. T01-0064 for the purpose of
21 requesting the Commission's approval regarding the
22 authorization for and construction of a bridge as an
23 alternative to the permanent closure of the crossing at
24 issue in this docket. The ALJ recommends denying the

1 motion to re-open, noting that LB Andersen Land Holding
2 is not an interested railroad company nor a public
3 body, and is, therefore, not the proper party to seek
4 the construction of a bridge.

5 Are there any objections to denying the
6 motion to re-open?

7 (No verbal response.)

8 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the motion to
9 re-open is denied.

10 Under our Administrative Matters,
11 Items AM-1 concerns a Commission resolution, pursuant
12 to Section 18c-1205 of the Illinois Commercial
13 Transportation Law, that appoints additional persons to
14 the Merit Advisory Board for the purpose of
15 interviewing and recommending candidates for the
16 positions of the Commission Police Officers.

17 Are there any objections to adopting
18 the resolution?

19 (No verbal response.)

20 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the resolution is
21 adopted.

22 Under our Other Business, Item OB-1
23 concerns Case No. 1-20-0279 in the Appellate Court of
24 Illinois, First Judicial District, which is Protective

1 Parking Service Corp v. ICC. This item involves
2 ongoing litigation, and therefore, we'll move into
3 closed session for our discussion.

4 Is there a motion to move into closed
5 session?

6 COMMISSIONER BOCANEGRA: I'll motion.

7 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Madam Chairman, I'll make
8 the motion to move the call.

9 COMMISSIONER MCCABE: Second.

10 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Okay. We have two motions and
11 a second, so I think we're good. Motioned by both
12 Commissioner Carrigan and Bocanegra and seconded by
13 Commissioner McCabe.

14 So all those in favor say "aye."

15 Aye.

16 COMMISSIONER BOCANEGRA: Aye.

17 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Aye.

18 COMMISSIONER KIMBREL: Aye.

19 COMMISSIONER MCCABE: Aye.

20 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: All opposed say "nay."

21 (No verbal response.)

22 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: The ayes have it and the motion
23 is granted.

24 So we're now going to move into Closed

1 Session, and I kindly ask all our members of the public
2 and any Commission Staff not participating in the
3 Closed Session to please exit the hearing rooms in
4 Chicago and Springfield.

5 (Whereupon, the meeting was moved into
6 Closed Session.)

7 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: So we're back on the live
8 stream, back in Open Session. And we're still under
9 Other Business Item OB-1, and so we are going to hold
10 this item for later disposition. So this concludes our
11 Transportation Agenda.

12 Judge Teague Kingsley, do we have other
13 matters to come before the Commission today?

14 JUDGE TEAGUE KINGSLEY: No, Madam Chair.

15 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Do you -- Commissioners have any
16 other business to discuss? Any comments?

17 (No verbal response.)

18 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, and without
19 objection, the meeting is now adjourned. Thank you.
