1 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Good morning. Under the Open  
2 Meetings Act, I call the January 19th, 2023, Regular  
3 Open Meeting to order. Commissioners Kimbrel and

18 We are moving on to our Transportation  
19 Agenda.

20 Items RR-1 through RR-10 concern  
21 various public safety improvement projects at railway  
22 crossings. The orders authorize the construction or

2 cost apportionment.

6 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders are

9 Item MC-1 concerns an application for a certificate of

18 approved. Item MC-2 concerns a stipulated agreement  
19 concerning alleged violations of the Illinois
