1 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Good morning, Commissioner
2 Carrigan. Are we ready to proceed in Springfield?

3 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: We are.

4 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Great. Then, under the
5 Open Meetings Act, I call the November 18th, 2021,
6 Regular Open Meeting to order. Commissioners
7 Bocanegra and Kimbrel are with me in Chicago, and
8 Commissioner Carrigan is in the Springfield office.
9 All commissioners are present. We have a quorum.
10 We have no requests to speak. We're going to move
11 right on to our agenda.

12 Under our Transportation agenda,
13 there are no edits to the October 21st and
14 November 4th, 2021, Transportation Regular Open
15 Meeting minutes.

16 Are there any objections to
17 approving the minutes?

18 (No verbal response.)

19 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the minutes
20 are approved.

21 Under our Railroad Items, Items
22 RR-1 through RR-5 concern various public safety

1 improvement projects at railroad crossings. The
2 orders approve the projects and approve or modify
3 project deadlines and cost apportionment. Are
4 there any objections to considering these items
5 together and approving the orders?

6 (No verbal response.)

7 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders
8 are approved.

9 Under our Motor Carrier Items,
10 Items MC-1 and MC-2 concern stipulated settlement
11 agreements on alleged violations of the Illinois
12 Commercial Transportation Law. The orders accept
13 the stipulated agreements. Are there any
14 objections to considering these items together and
15 approving the orders?

16 (No verbal response.)

17 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders
18 are approved.

19 Items MC-3 and MC-4 concern
20 applications for renewal of commercial vehicle
21 relocator licenses. The orders grant the
22 applications, finding that the applicants meet the

1 licensing requirements. Are there any objections
2 to considering these items together and approving
3 the orders?

4 (No verbal response.)

5 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders
6 are approved.

7 Item MC-5 concerns an application
8 for an operator's employment permit. The order
9 finds that the applicant is fit to hold an
10 operator's permit and grants the permit. Are there
11 any objections to approving the order?

12 (No verbal response.)

13 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order is
14 approved.
