1 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: I did check all the
2 commissioners. I know we're looking at a video with
3 Commissioner Kimbrel's chair empty, but he is dialed
4 in. So we'll do roll call and phone text as well.

5 Commissioner Bocanegra.

6 COMMISSIONER BOCANEGRA: Good morning, Carrie.

7 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Commissioner Carrigan.

8 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Good morning, Chairman.

9 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Thank you. Commissioner
10 Kimbrel.

11 COMMISSIONER KIMBREL: Good morning, Madam Chair.
12 I apologize for the video feed. I need to work that
13 out.

14 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: No worries. Commissioner Oliva.

15 COMMISSIONER OLIVA: Yes, I'm here. Good
16 morning.

17 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Judge Teague-Kingsley, can you
18 hear us?

19 JUDGE TEAGUE-KINGSLEY: Yes, I can hear you,
20 Madam Chairman.

21 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Great. Under the Open Meetings
22 Act and in accordance with the governor's executive

1 orders, I call the March 4, 2021 regular open meeting
2 to order. Before we proceed, for clarity of the
3 record, I would ask everyone to state their name
4 before speaking and to speak slowly and clearly so
5 that the court reporter can capture everything that
6 is said. I have already checked, we have all five
7 commissioners on with us. We have no requests to
8 speak. So we're going to move right on to our
9 transportation agenda.

10 There are edits to the February 4, 2021
11 transportation regular open meeting minutes. Are
12 there any objections to approving the minutes as
13 edited?

14 (No response.)

15 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the minutes are
16 approved. Items RR-1 through RR-4 concern public
17 safety improvement projects at railway crossings.
18 The orders approve the projects, extend the projects'
19 deadlines and approve costs apportionment. Are there
20 any objections to considering these items together
21 and approving the orders?

22 (No response.)

1 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders are
2 approved.

3 Under our motor carrier items, Item MC-1
4 concerns a stipulated settlement agreement concerning
5 alleged violations of the Illinois Commercial
6 Transportation Law. The order accepts the stipulated
7 agreement. Are there any objections to approving the
8 order?

9 (No response.)

10 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order it is
11 approved.

12 Items M-C2 and MC-3 concern applications for
13 new household goods, property, motor carrier
14 authority and public carrier certificate. The orders
15 grant temporary one year certificates, finding that
16 the applicants meet the requirements. Are there any
17 objections to considering these items together and
18 approving the orders?

19 (No response.)

20 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders are
21 approved.

22 Item MC-4 concerns an application for an

1 operator employment permit to operate relocation
2 towing vehicles. Applicant's sponsoring employer
3 filed a letter indicating that the applicant was no
4 longer employed by the sponsor. The order dismisses
5 the application without prejudice for lack of a
6 sponsoring employer. Are there any objections to
7 approving the order?

8 (No response.)

9 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order is
10 approved.

11 Moving on to our collateral recovery items,
12 Items CR-1 and CR-2 concern applications for Class E
13 recovery permits. We are going to hold these items
14 for later dispositions. So this concludes our
15 transportation agenda.

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
