

1 CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Under the Open Meetings Act, I
2 call the February 3, 2022 Regular Open Meeting to
3 order. Consistent with Section 7(e) of the Open
4 Meetings Act, a fully in-person meeting is not prudent
5 at this time due to Winter Storm Landon and
6 Governor J.B. Pritzker's Disaster Proclamation. So we
7 are proceeding pursuant to Section 7(e). I checked
8 that we have all five commissioners present, so we have
9 a quorum.

10 Moving on to our Transportation Agenda.
11 There are edits to the January 5, 2022 Transportation
12 Regular Open Meeting Minutes. If you are in favor of
