1           CHAIR ZALEWSKI: Under the Open Meetings Act, I  
2 call the September 1st, 2022, regular opening to order.

5 requests to speak.

6                       We're moving onto our Transportation  
7 Agenda. There are edits to the August 11th, 2022,  
8 Regular Open Meeting minutes.

9                       Are there any objections to approving  
10 the minutes as edited?

11                      (No verbal response.)

12                      Hearing none, the minutes are approved.

13                      Under our railroad items, Item RR-1  
14 concerns public safety improvement projects at railway  
15 crossings in St. Clair County. The order approves the  
16 project and project deadlines.

17                      Are there any objections to approving  
18 the order?

19                      (No verbal response.)

20                      Hearing none, the order is approved.

21                      Item RR-2 concerns public safety  
22 improvement projects at railway crossings in Madison

1 County. The order vacates the previous order issued in  
2 this docket, terminates the stipulated agreement and  
3 dismisses the docket as agreed upon by the parties.

4 Are there any objections to approving  
5 the order?

6 (No verbal response.)

7 Hearing none, the order is approved.

8 Under our Motor Carrier Items, Item  
9 MC-1 concerns a stipulated settlement agreement  
10 regarding alleged violations of the Illinois Commercial  
11 Transportation law. The order accepts the stipulated  
12 agreement.

16 Hearing none, the order is approved.

17 Item MC-2 concerns an application for a  
18 renewal of a Commercial Relocator's License. The  
19 Petitioner failed to appear at the hearings and failed

13 Items MC-4 through MC-6 concern  
14 applications for an Operator's Employment Permit. The  
15 orders dismiss the applications finding that the  
16 applicants failed to appear at hearings and are not fit  
17 to provide the services.

21 Hearing none, the orders are approved  
22 under our collateral recovery items, Item CR-1 concerns

1 an application for a Class E recovery permit. The  
2 order dismisses the application finding that the  
3 Applicant did not appear at the hearing and stated he  
4 no longer wished to pursue the application.
