1 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Then under the Open
2 Meetings Act, I call the September 15, 2022,
3 Regular Open Meeting to order. Commissioners
4 Kimbrel, Carrigan and McCabe are with me in
5 Springfield rather.

6 We have a quorum.

7 First onto our transportation agenda.
8 There are edits to the August 17th and September
9 1st, 2022 Transportation Regular Open Meeting
10 minutes.

11 Are there any objections to approving the

14 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
15 minutes are approved.

16 Under our Railroad items, Items RR-1 and
17 RR-2 concern public safety improvement projects at
18 railway crossings. The Orders approve the
19 projects, extend project deadlines and cost
20 apportionment.

21 Are there any objections to considering
22 these items together and approving the Orders?

1 (No response.)

2 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
3 Orders are approved.

4 Item RR-3 concerns Department of
5 Transportation's petition for approval of the
6 taking of certain property owned by a common
7 transportation carrier in Cook County for a public
8 highway. The Order approves the taking of the
9 property for public use finding that IDOT's
10 acquisition and construction project will not
11 unreasonably interfere with railroad operations.

12 Are there any objections to approving the
13 Order?

14 (No response.)

15 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
16 Order is approved.

17 Items RR-4 through RR-8 concern stipulated
18 agreements regarding improving public safety at
19 railway crossings. The orders accept the terms of
20 stipulated agreements, approve project deadlines
21 and cost apportionment.

22 Are there any objections to considering

1 these items together and approving the Orders?

2 (No response.)

3 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
4 Orders are approved.

5 Under our Motor Carrier items, Item MC-1
6 concerns a stipulated settlement agreement
7 regarding alleged violations of the Illinois
8 Commercial Transportation Law. The Order accepts
9 the stipulated agreement.

10 Are there any objections to approving the
11 Order?

12 (No response.)

13 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
14 Order is approved.

15 Items MC-2 and MC-3 concern applications
16 for Certificates of Public Convenience and
17 Necessity. The Orders grant temporary common and
18 contract carrier certificates for household goods
19 and other commodities finding that the applicants
20 meet the requirements.

21 Are there any objections to considering
22 these items together and approving the Orders?

1 (No response.)

2 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
3 Orders are approved.

4 Items MC-4 through MC-7 concern
5 applications for dispatcher and operator employment
6 permits. The Orders dismiss the applications
7 finding that the applicants have no sponsoring
8 relocators and did not further pursue nor appear at
9 hearings.

10 Are there any objections to considering
11 these items together and approving the Orders?

12 (No response.)

13 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
14 Orders are approved.

15 Under our Collateral Recovery items, Items
16 MC-1 and MC 2 concern applications for Class E
17 recovery permits. The Orders dismiss the
18 applications for want of prosecution.

19 Are there any objections to considering
20 these items together and approving the Orders?

21 (No response.)

22 CHAIRPERSON ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the

1 Orders are approved.
