1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Good morning. Under the
2 Open Meetings Act, I call the June 29, 2023, regular
3 open meeting to order. Commissioners Carrigan,
4 McCabe, and Reddick are with me in Springfield. We
5 have a quorum. We have no requests to speak today.

6 Moving on to our transportation agenda.
7 There are edits to the June 1st regular opening
8 meeting minutes.

13 are approved as edited.

14 Items RR-1 through RR-18 concern various
15 public safety improvement projects at railroad
16 crossings. The orders approve the projects, extend

23 Moving on to our motor carrier items.

1 Items MC-1 and MC-2 concern applications for
2 new household goods property motor carrier authority.

4 applicants meet the requirements.

9 are approved.

10 Item MC-3 concerns an application for
11 renewal of a commercial relocation towing license.
12 The order grants the renewal, finding that the
13 applicant meets the requirements.

17 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the order is
18 approved.

19 Items MC-4 and MC-5 concern alleged
20 violations of Illinois Commercial Safety Towing Law.
21 Parties in both cases have reached a stipulated
22 settlement agreement, and the orders accept the
23 agreements.
