2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Good morning.

3 Under the Open Meetings Act, I call the
4 September 14th, 2023, Regular Open Meeting to order.

5 Commissioners Carrigan, McCabe, Reddick, and
6 Paradis are with me in Springfield. We have a quorum.

7 We have no requests to speak today.

9 Moving on to our Transportation agenda.

10

11 Items RR-1 and RR-2 concern public safety
12 improvement projects at railway crossings in Illinois.
13 The Orders approve the projects, projects' deadlines,
14 and costs apportionment.

15 Are there any objections to considering these
16 items together and approving the Orders?

17 (No verbal response.)

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the orders are
19 approved.

20 Moving on to our Motor Carriers items.

21 Items MC-1 through MC-3 concern Stipulated
22 Settlement Agreements regarding alleged violations of

1 the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law. The Orders
2 accept the Stipulated Agreements.

3 Are there any objections to considering these
4 items together and approving the Orders?

5 (No verbal response.)

6 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Orders are
7 approved.

8 Item MC-4 concerns an application for a
9 certificate of public convenience and necessity to
10 transport household goods. The order grants the
11 certificate, finding that the applicant meets the
12 requirements.

13 Are there any objections to approving the
14 order?

15 (No verbal response.)

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the order is
17 approved.

18 Item MC-5 concerns an application for renewal
19 of a commercial relocation towing license. The order
20 grants the application, finding that the applicant meets
21 the licensing requirements.

22 Are there any objections to approving the

1 order?

2 (No verbal response.)

3 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the order is
4 approved.

5 Item MC-6 concerns an application for
6 Commercial Vehicle Relocator's Towing License. The
7 order grants the application, finding that the applicant
8 meets the requirements.

9 Are there any objections to approving the
10 order?

11 (No verbal response.)

12 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the order is
13 approved.

14 Item MC-7 concerns a petition to increase the
15 Petitioners' and Intervenors' maximum light-duty
16 relocation towing rates from \$216 to \$250 per tow and
17 the daily relocation storage rate, after the first 24
18 hours, from \$45 per day to \$55 per day. The petitioners
19 also seek to pass additional costs imposed by local
20 ordinances on to persons whose vehicles are relocated.

21 The Order finds that the requested increases
22 by the petitioners are not factually supported by the

1 record. However, to ensure that towing revenues are not
2 outpaced by costs, the Order increases the Petitioners'
3 and Intervenors' rates to the current maximum light-duty
4 towing rate of \$238.20; The Order denies the requests to
5 increase storage rates and pass-through the costs of
6 municipal fees on to vehicle owners.

7 Are there any objections to approving the
8 order?

9 (No verbal response.)

10 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the order is
11 approved.
