Dear Gentleperson:

Two towing companies in Chicago, Lincoln Towing and Rendered Services, are notorious for stealing legally parked cars and holding them for ransom. They stole three from my lot. Regular appeals, and letters to political representatives, the Cook County States Atty. and the Illinois States Atty., have been ignored or they refused to act.

Their continual thefts have been documented by DNAinfo Radio, NBC's Ron Mages, Tribune and Sun Times Reporters, musically portrayed in Steve Goodman's "Lincoln Park Pirates", and, most recently in a Chicago City Council hearing.

By your own records 4,854 formal complaints have been filed with your organization. Probably four or five times that number of cars have been stolen, because most people just pay the ransom. Common knowledge is that filing a formal complaint with the ICC is a futile exercise because you do nothing.
