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- 1 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: By the power vested in
- 2 me by the State of Illinois and the Illinois
- 3 Commerce Commission, I now call for status hearing
- 4 Docket No. 74 RTV-R Sub 15 for hearing. This is in
- 5 the matter of Rendered Services, Inc., and the
- 6 nature of the case is the hearing fitness to hold a
- 7 Commercial Vehicle Relocator's License.
- 8 May I have appearances, please. Let's
- 9 start with Rendered.
- 10 MR. ROTHSCHILD: Good afternoon, your Honor. My
- 11 name is Donald S. Rothschild. I represent the
- 12 respondent, Rendered Services, Inc. My business
- 13 address is 835 McClintock Drive, Burr Ridge,
- 14 Illinois, 60527, and I'm an attorney licensed by the
- 15 Supreme Court.
- 16 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Thank you.
- MR. DOHERTY: Good afternoon, your Honor. Brian
- Doherty, same contact information as Mr. Rothschild.
- 19 I am also an attorney licensed by the Illinois
- 20 Supreme Court.
- JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Thank you.
- 22 Staff.

- 1 MR. BARR: Good afternoon, your Honor. Benjamin
- 2 Barr on behalf of staff the Illinois Commerce
- 3 Commission. My office is located at 160 North
- 4 La Salle Street, Suite 800, Chicago, Illinois,
- 5 60601. My telephone number is 312-814-2859.
- 6 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay. Thank you. This
- 7 is a status hearing, so I'll just open the floor to
- 8 get an update.
- 9 MR. ROTHSCHILD: So, as you may recall, we were
- 10 last here in June, I believe, to hear the status of
- 11 our ongoing discovery. We had scheduled some -- we
- 12 had accomplished some of the oral discovery, but
- 13 there's extensive oral discovery involving staff
- 14 witnesses, Rendered witnesses, citizen witnesses, to
- 15 be done.
- We then got together, staff -- or
- 17 transportation counsel and myself and decided to
- 18 take a stab at trying to resolve this amicably.
- As you may recall, I was going to be
- 20 away for a few weeks, so that delayed it a bit, but
- 21 I did tender to Mr. Barr a draft proposal. I'm not
- 22 going to share that with your Honor at this point,

- 1 which he, I'm advised, is currently reviewing with
- 2 management at the Transportation Division.
- 3 We are hopeful the matter can be
- 4 resolved. We have put a lot of thought and effort
- 5 into coming up with our proposal, and we also
- 6 believed that it would be the best use of the
- 7 Commission's resources as well as Rendered's
- 8 resources, not to even mention your time and efforts
- 9 if the matter could be resolved by some type of an
- 10 agreed disposition.
- MR. BARR: That's correct, your Honor. We did
- see a proposal this week and attempted to settle. I
- think it's a jumping off point. I think I have
- 14 talked to counsel prior to the start of today's
- 15 status hearing that we are still reviewing it.
- We plan on making some counterpoints
- 17 back to counsel. We hope to have that done by the
- 18 end of the month and then our thoughts were to set a
- 19 mid-September status hearing. I think at that point
- 20 we will really know whether we can try to get this
- 21 done either by settlement or we just need to
- 22 continue forward towards oral discovery depositions

- 1 towards an evidentiary date.
- JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: So the oral discovery
- 3 has not occurred obviously.
- 4 MR. ROTHSCHILD: No. We've stated --
- JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: You are trying to work
- 6 this out first?
- 7 MR. ROTHSCHILD: It would be I think foolhardy to
- 8 put the time and effort into that, and we also have
- 9 some unresolved issues as to citizen witnesses and
- 10 how those were going to be handled, because you may
- 11 recall I spent a lot of money tracking down someone
- 12 that told us that at his deposition that he would
- 13 have come voluntarily if cordially invited.
- JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: So we are looking at --
- MR. ROTHSCHILD: Hopefully we won't have to get
- 16 into that.
- JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay. So we are
- 18 looking at mid-September.
- 19 MR. ROTHSCHILD: Yes.
- JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: How's September 13th?
- 21 MR. ROTHSCHILD: That is a bad day for me I know
- 22 for sure.

- 1 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: What about any day that
- 2 week?
- 3 MR. ROTHSCHILD: The 15th would be about the only
- 4 day that week. We could do it in the morning.
- JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: What about the next
- 6 week?
- 7 MR. ROTHSCHILD: The next week is good. There is
- 8 a religious holiday that I have. I could actually
- 9 do it on the 20th if you scheduled it at this time
- 10 of day.
- MR. BARR: That works for staff, your Honor.
- 12 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: That works. 3 o'clock?
- 13 MR. ROTHSCHILD: Yes.
- 14 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: All right. So this
- matter will be continued to September 20th at 3 p.m.
- 16 here in Chicago and we'll reconvene at that time and
- 17 wish the best for your settlement efforts.
- 18 MR. ROTHSCHILD: One other point of information.
- 19 There are a number of pending administrative
- 20 citations that I understand are being continued.
- 21 Part of the settlement will address presumably
- 22 everything that's out there.

1	MR. BARR: Those were included on the memo.
2	JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay.

4	was adjourned, to be
