1           JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: By the power vested  
2 in me by the State of Illinois and the Illinois  
3 Commerce Commission, I now call Docket No.  
4 92 RTV-R Sub 17 for a status hearing. This is in the  
5 matter of Protective Parking Service Corporation  
6 doing business as Lincoln Towing Service. And this  
7 is a status on the hearing on the Fitness to Hold a  
8 Commercial Vehicle Relocator's License.

9                   May I have appearances, please? Let's  
10 start with Staff.

11           MR. BARR: Good morning, your Honor. Benjamin  
12 Barr on behalf of the Staff of the Illinois Commerce

5             MR. CHIRICA: Good morning, your Honor. My

11            JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay. Mr. Perl, if  
12    you could just go on the record and state what  
13    occurred after the last hearing, the discovery  
14    request you made and where we are right now.

15            MR. PERL: Thank you, Judge.

16                    We did receive documents in answer to  
17    respondent's second data request on October 13th. We  
18    will need some time to take a look at them and either  
19    put a response together or a motion. We're  
20    requesting 21 days to do that.

21                    And subsequent to that, I believe that  
22    we are about to schedule some dates for the hearing

1 going forward. I'm not sure if your Honor wants me  
2 to present the dates or if you want to do it.

3 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: I'll get them on the  
4 record.

5 Prior to going on the record, we  
6 decided the following dates to continue the  
7 evidentiary hearing in this proceeding:

8 The next hearing date will be Tuesday,  
9 January 16th, 2018, starting at 9:00 a.m. Throughout  
10 the day -- we'll just block the whole day, but we'll  
11 see where we go.

12 The following day, January 17th, 2018,  
13 starting at 9:00 a.m. And we said the following day,  
14 January 18th, at 9:00 a.m.

15 The next hearing date thereafter will  
16 be January 24th, 2018, 9:00 a.m. January 25th, 2018,  
17 9:00 a.m.

18 The next date will be Tuesday, January  
19 30th, at 1:30 p.m. The next date being January 31st,  
20 starting at 9:00 a.m. The following day February  
21 1st, starting at 9:00 a.m.

22 And we are also going to hold open

1 February 13th, 2018, Tuesday, at 9:00 a.m. as well as  
2 February 14th, 2018, at 9:00 a.m.

3 So we have several dates locked.  
4 Hopefully we'll be able to proceed on those days, and  
5 we'll go from there.

6 So I think that's it for today. Is  
7 there anything else that anyone else wants to  
8 present?

9 MR. BARR: Nothing further, your Honor.
