Quarterly Highlights

- 1. Peoples Gas made steady progress during the third quarter, including 27 miles of main installed, more than 2,000 services installed, and 4,000 meters moved.
 - While there are some variances in the quarterly metrics due to some project delays, we have pivoted work in the neighborhoods to optimize our resources and we remain on target to largely meet the overall annual program plan.
- 2. Our project remains on target and budget year-to-date: Neighborhood cost per install mile and cost per meter move are aligned with the plan for the year. Neighborhood main and service installation, as well as meter installations are also aligned with the plan.
- 3. Field work continued on the Central Extension, also referred to as Segment 8 within the High Pressure portfolio of work. This project provides backbone support for gas supply into the Central Business District. As shown on the cover photo, this 16" main installation work is progressing on the night shift to reduce the impact on traffic in the area.

Dear Chairman Scott and Commissioners Carrigan, McCabe, Reddick and Paradis:

We are pleased to submit our quarterly report for the Peoples Gas Safety Modernization Program (SMP) in compliance with the ICC's order in docket 16-0376. Here are a few highlights from the third quarter of 2023.

Neighborhood Work

Our work across more than 12 neighborhoods throughout the city continues, with cost per mile aligned with the plan for the year. Year-to-date main and services installations continue to be aligned with the plan, with nearly 19 miles and 1,619 services installed, respectively, during the third quarter.

Jeffery Manor and Chatham

Earlier this year in Jeffery Manor, we identified the risk of encountering underground soil conditions that could slow progress on our upgrade. Our project management team developed a contingency plan in case adverse soil conditions were found, which they were. By identifying the risk early, our team was able to quickly pivot by ramping up design and construction in the Chatham neighborhood and maximizing the full use of all resources while the soil conditions in Jeffery Manor were mitigated. We now are a mile ahead on both main installation and retirement in Chatham. Overall, South Side neighborhood projects are projected to meet or exceed targets for 2023.

High pressure line

Working with the Chicago and Illinois departments of transportation to reduce the impact on traffic, Peoples Gas moved construction work on the new high pressure line being installed on the Near West Side from daytime to night. The change reduced the traffic impact to Roosevelt Road and the University of Illinois Chicago. The high pressure line will tie into a medium pressure section of our delivery system and ensure reliability in the Central Business District.

We look forward to continuing to partner with you to improve the safety, reliability and environmental sustainability of our delivery system. As always, feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns.

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2. Summary Observations & Analysis

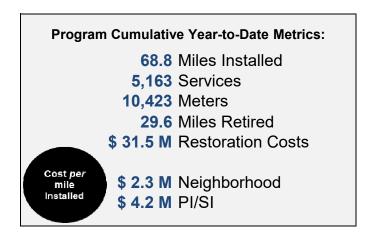
Enclosed is Peoples Gas' Safety Modernization Program (SMP) third quarter 2023 Report. The information displayed on the pages that follow are actual results recorded from January 2023 through September 2023 as measured against the 2023 plan. The 2023 plan is shown through the blue lines and bars throughout the report.

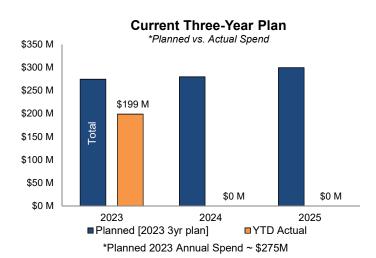
Execution of the planned installation and retirement quantities involved a dedicated and technical workforce, and coordination and collaboration with various groups and thousands of customers. During the third quarter, steady progress was made, including 27 miles of main installed, more than 2,000 services installed, 4,000 meters moved and about 15 miles of main retired. Tables and graphs on the following pages show progress and performance through the third quarter. Specific highlights include:

- For Neighborhood work, the year-to-date cost per installed mile is aligned with the plan, as shown on page 7. Main installation year-to-date continues to be aligned with the plan, with nearly 19 miles installed during the third quarter. As discussed in the opening letter to the Commissioners, proactive project management enabled neighborhood work to progress in line with the plan, despite challenging underground field conditions.
- Public Improvement/System Improvement (PI/SI) cost per installed mile declined during the third quarter. Main installation and retirement for the quarter was aligned with the quarter plan, but still is less than overall year-to-date plan. The variance is comprised of several different project locations, primarily due to third party coordination. See pages 10 12 for the PI/SI Program metrics.
- Cost per meter move and quantities of meter moved are aligned with the plan for the third quarter and year-to-date. Project teams continue to balance labor resource needs across compliance driven, customer driven, and construction-related workloads. As we enter the heating season, the balancing of resources will continue throughout the fourth quarter. Metrics related to meter moves are on pages 13 and 14.
- This year's work under the High Pressure Program involves starting the installation of the Central Extension, also referred to as Segment 8. This project includes approximately one mile of 16" main installation and will provide backbone support for gas supply into the Central Business District. As shown in the cover photo, work continued on this installation during the third quarter. It will continue into mid-2024.

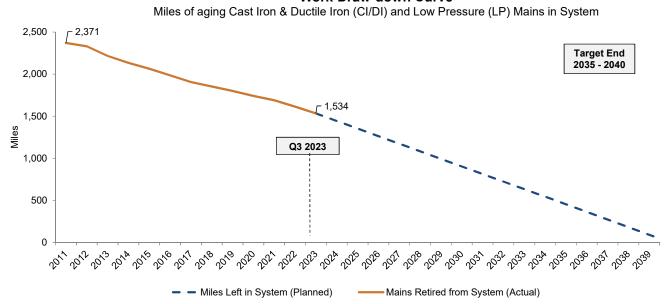

Work Draw-down Curve

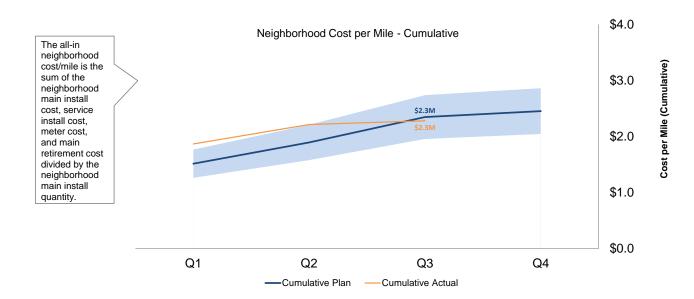

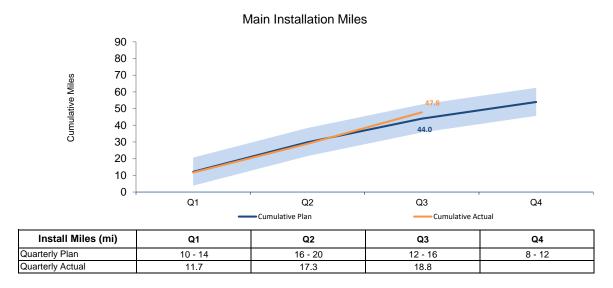

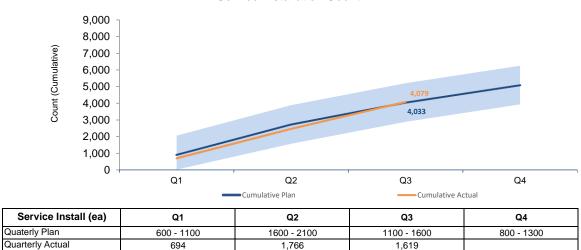

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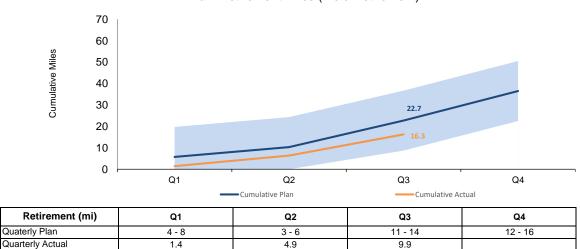

Main Retirement Miles (Field Retirement)



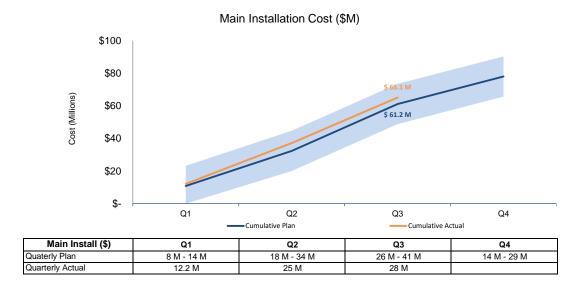

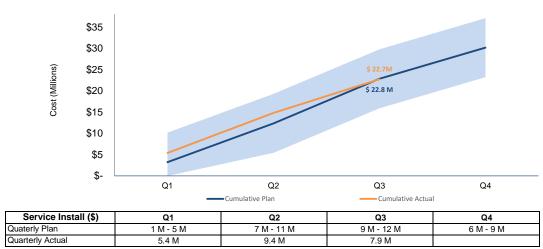

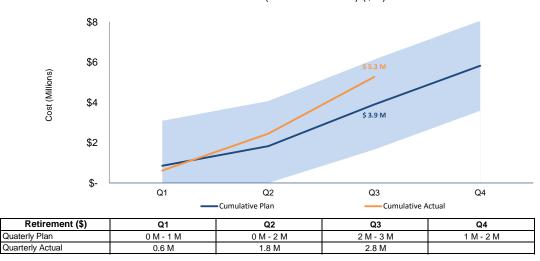
4C. Neighborhood - Cost Graphs



Service Installation Cost (\$M)



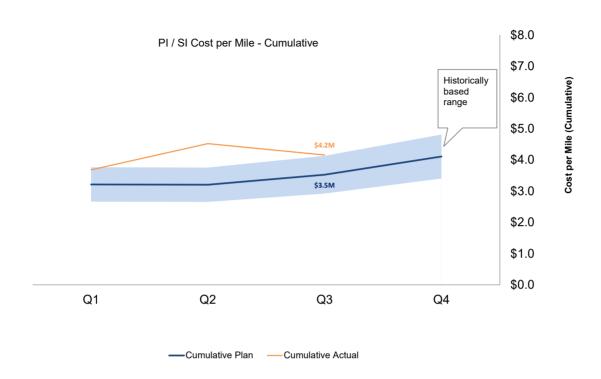
Main Retirement Cost (Field Retirement) (\$M)

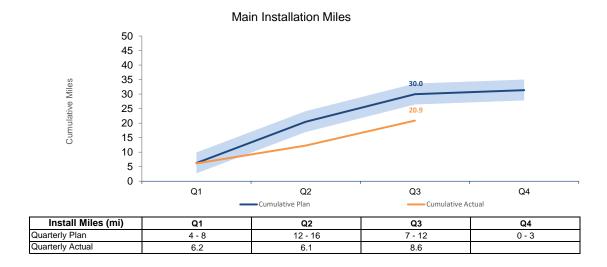

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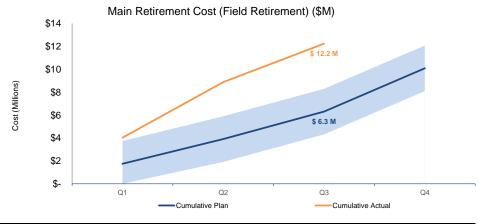
5C. Public Improvement / System Improvement - Cost Graphs

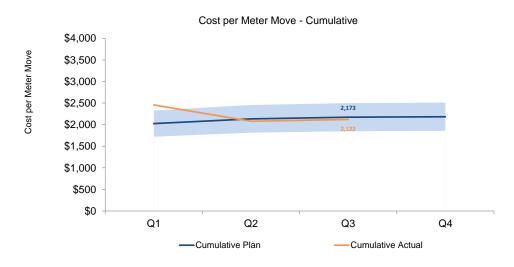

6A. Meter Moves Program Performance



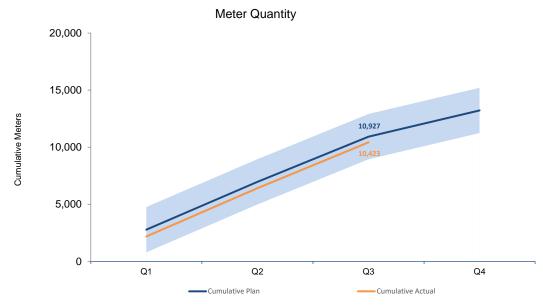

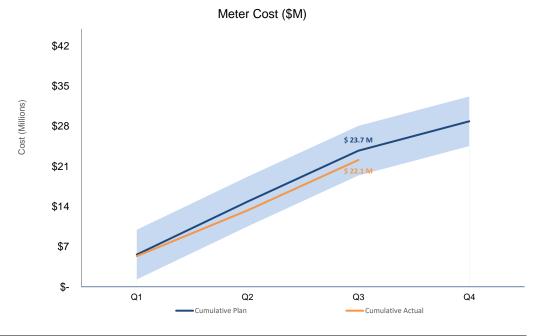

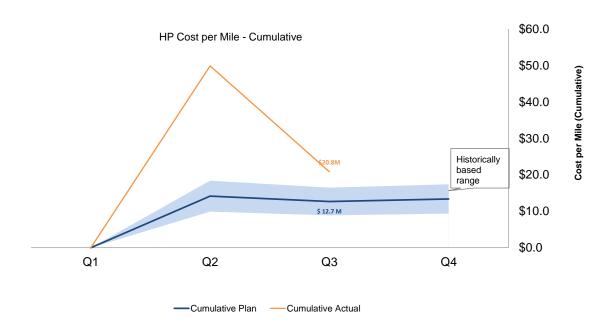

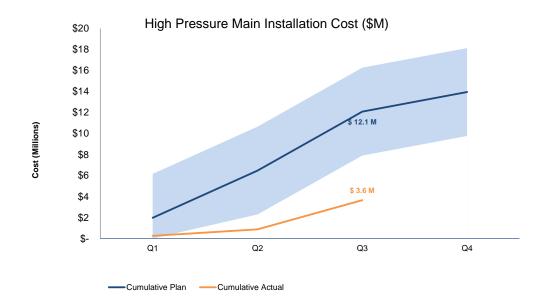
